Lesson #114: “Is Not This the Carpenter's Son?”

Mark 6:3 (KJV)

Is not this the carpenter, the son of Mary, the brother of James, and Joses, and of Juda, and Simon? and are not his sisters here with us? And they were offended at him.

This week boys and girls, we will begin a new chapter in our lesson entitle,
“Is Not This the Carpenter's Son?” of our study book!

Luke 4:16 (KJV)

And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: and, as his custom was, he went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and stood up for to read.

Luke 4:20 (KJV)

Luke 4:22 (KJV)

And all bare him witness, and wondered at the gracious words which proceeded out of his mouth. And they said, Is not this Joseph's son?

Let's continue in our book Desire of Ages, Chapter #24, page 236 - 237

Across the bright days of Christ's ministry in Galilee, one shadow lay. The people of Nazareth rejected Him. "Is not this the carpenter's son?" they said. {DA 236.1}

During His childhood and youth, Jesus had worshiped among His brethren in the synagogue at Nazareth. Since the opening of His ministry He had been absent from them, but they had not been ignorant of what had befallen Him. As He again appeared among them, their interest and expectation were excited to the highest pitch. Here were the familiar forms and faces of those whom He had known from infancy. Here were His mother, His brothers and sisters, and all eyes were turned upon Him as He entered the synagogue upon the Sabbath day, and took His place among the worshipers. {DA 236.2}

Question: what shadow lay across the bright days of Christ Ministry in Galilee? And where had Jesus worshiped during His Childhood and youth?

Answer: The people of Nazareth rejected Him. And, in the synagogue at Nazareth.

In the regular service for the day, the elder read from the prophets, and exhorted the people still to hope for the Coming One, who would bring in a glorious reign, and banish all oppression. He sought to encourage his hearers by rehearsing the evidence that the Messiah's coming was near. He described the glory of His advent, keeping prominent the thought that He would appear at the head of armies to deliver Israel. {DA 236.3}

When a rabbi was present at the synagogue, he was expected to deliver the sermon, and any Israelite might give the reading from the prophets. Upon this Sabbath Jesus was requested to take part in the service. He "stood up for to read. And there was delivered unto Him the book of the prophet Esaias." **Luke 4:16-17, margin.** The scripture which He read was one that was understood as referring to the Messiah:

Question: What reading of prophets did the elders use to exhorted the people, regarding what the Coming One would bring? And upon the Sabbath when Jesus was requested to take part in the service, which book did he read from?

Answer: The Coming One would bring in a glorious reign, and banish all oppression. And there was delivered unto Him the book of the prophet Isaiah.

"The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He hath anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor; He hath sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To preach deliverance to the captives, And recovering of sight to the blind, To set at liberty them that are bruised, To preach the acceptable year of the Lord." {DA 236.4}

"And he closed the book, and he gave [it] again to the minister, and sat down. And the eyes of all them that were in the synagogue were fastened on him. . . . And all bare Him witness, and wondered at the gracious words which proceeded out of His mouth." **Luke 4:20-22, margin.** {DA 237.1}

Question: What was upon the Lord and why? And, what was Christ sent to do?

Answer: The Spirit of the Lord is upon Him, because He hath anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor; He hath sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To preach deliverance to the captives, And recovering of sight to the blind, To set at liberty them that are bruised, To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.

Song: *Let's learn a beautiful scripture song dear one from the **book of Isaiah** together!*

Isaiah 61:1-3 (KJV)

The spirit of the Lord GOD [is] upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, **to proclaim** liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to [them that are] bound; **To proclaim** the acceptable year of the LORD, **and the day** of vengeance of our God; **to comfort** all that mourn;

To appoint **unto them that mourn** in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.

Jesus stood before the people as a living expositor of the prophecies concerning Himself. Explaining the words He had read, He spoke of the Messiah as a reliever of the oppressed, a liberator of captives, a healer of the afflicted, restoring sight to the blind, and revealing to the world the light of truth. His impressive manner and the wonderful import of His words thrilled the hearers with a power they had never felt before. The tide of divine influence broke every barrier down; like Moses, they beheld the Invisible. As their hearts were moved upon by the Holy Spirit, they responded with fervent amens and praises to the Lord. {DA 237.2}

Question: How did the hearers respond to Jesus' words as a living expositor of the prophecies concerning Himself?

Answer: Of His words thrilled the hearers with a power they had never felt before. The tide of divine influence broke every barrier down; like Moses, they beheld the Invisible. As their hearts were moved upon by the Holy Spirit, they responded with fervent amens and praises to the Lord.

But when Jesus announced, "This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears," they were suddenly recalled to think of themselves, and of the claims of Him who had been addressing them. They, Israelites, children of Abraham, had been represented as in bondage. They had been addressed as prisoners to be delivered from the power of evil; as in darkness, and needing the light of truth. Their pride was offended, and their fears were roused. The words of Jesus indicated that His work for them was to be altogether different from what they desired. Their deeds might be investigated too closely. Notwithstanding their exactness in outward ceremonies, they shrank from inspection by those clear, searching eyes. {DA 237.3}

Question: But when Jesus announced, "This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears," what were they suddenly recalled to think of themselves and of the claims of Him who had been addressing them?

Answer: They, Israelites, children of Abraham, had been represented as in bondage. And, they had been addressed as prisoners to be delivered from the power of evil; as in darkness, and needing the light of truth. Their pride was offended, and their fears were roused.

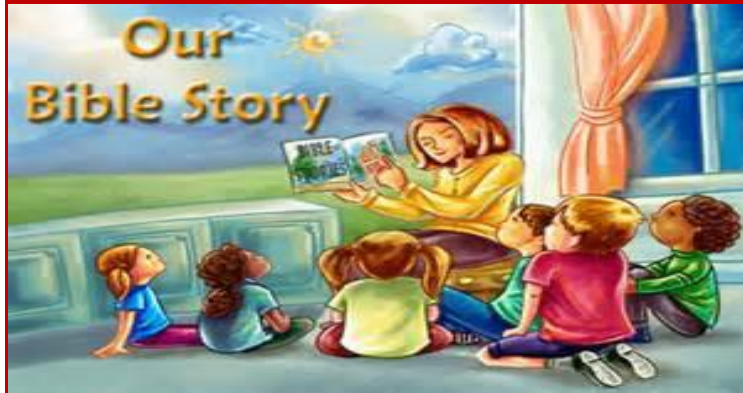

The anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him. **1 John 2:27. {SD 30.1}**

It is the Spirit itself that teaches and **enlightens**. The most powerful preaching of the Word, the reading of the Scriptures, will not be able to transform the character and save souls unless the Spirit works with and through the human agents. The planning and **devising** must not be of a character to draw attention to self. The Word is a power, a sword, in the hands of the human agent, but the Holy Spirit in its **vital** power is the **efficiency** to impress the mind. "They shall be all taught of God." It is God that causes the light to shine into hearts. ... The reason why God can do so little for us is that we forget that living virtue in the Holy Spirit is to combine with the human agent. **{SD 30.2}**

With the great truth we have been **privileged** to receive, we should, and under the Holy Spirit's power we could, become living channels of light. We could then approach the **mercy-seat**; and seeing the bow of promise, kneel with **contrite** hearts, and seek the kingdom of heaven with a spiritual violence that would bring its own reward. We would take it by force, as did Jacob. Then our message would be the power of God unto salvation. Our supplications would be full of earnestness, full of a sense of our great need; and we would not be denied. The truth would be expressed by life and character, and by lips touched with the living coal from off God's altar. When this experience is ours, we shall be lifted out of our poor, cheap selves, that we have cherished so tenderly. We shall empty our hearts of the **corroding** power of selfishness, and shall be filled with praise and **gratitude** to God. We shall magnify the Lord, the God of all grace, who has magnified Christ. And He will reveal His power through us, making us as sharp sickles in the **harvest-field**. **{SD 30.3}**

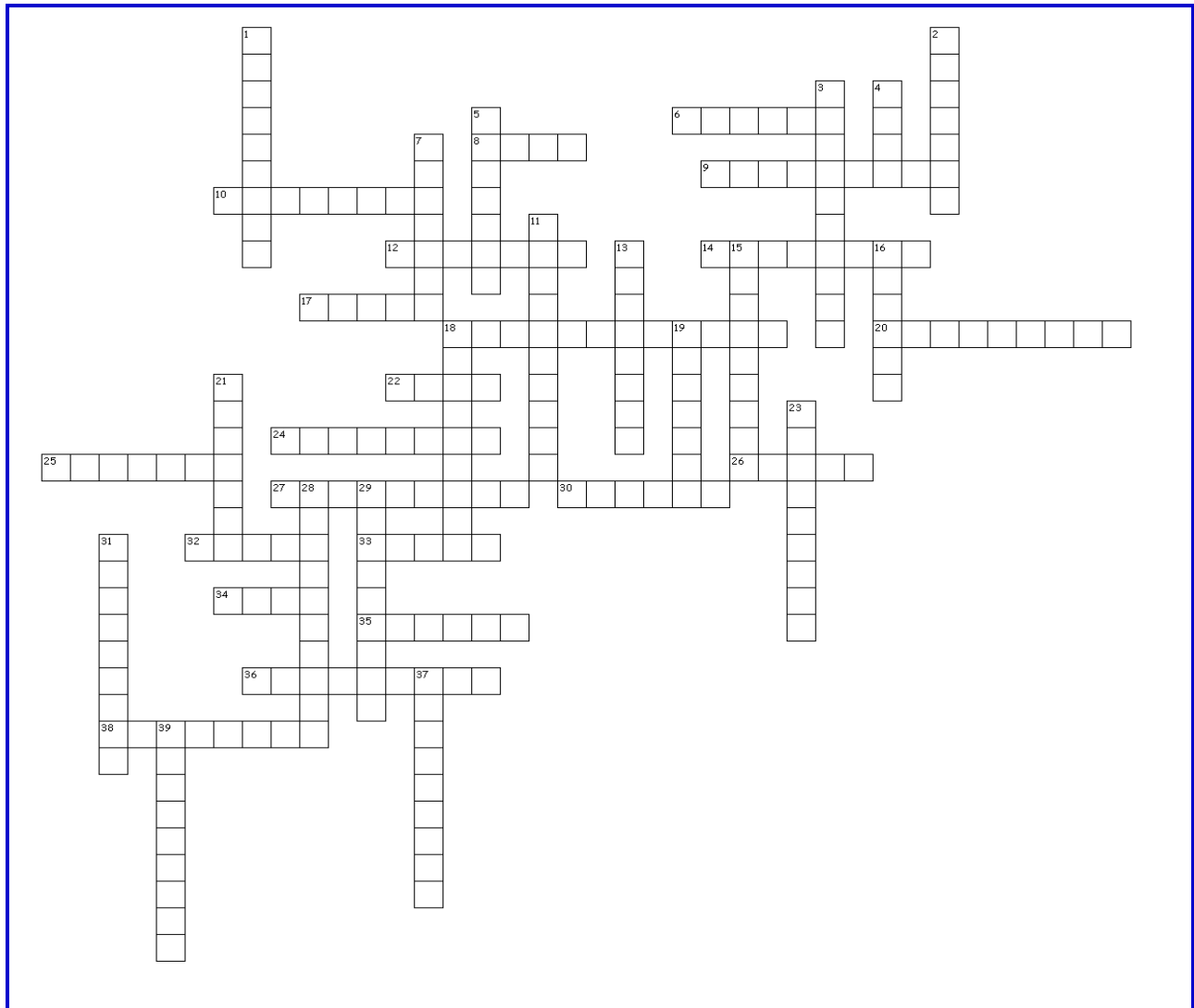
