Lesson #118: “The Call by the Sea”

Luke 5:1-2 (KJV)

And it came to pass, that, as the people pressed upon him to hear the word of God, he stood by the lake of Gennesaret, And saw two ships standing by the lake: but the fishermen were gone out of them, and were washing [their] nets.

*This week boys and girls, we will begin a new chapter of our lesson entitle,
“The Call by the Sea” of our study book Desire of Ages!*

Luke 5:3 (KJV)

And he entered into one of the ships, which was Simon's, and prayed him that he would thrust out a little from the land. And he sat down, and taught the people out of the ship.

Luke 5:4 (KJV)

Now when he had left speaking, he said unto Simon, Launch out into the deep, and let down your nets for a draught.

Luke 5:5 (KJV)

And Simon answering said unto him, Master, we have toiled all the night, and have taken nothing: nevertheless at thy word I will let down the net.

Luke 5:6 (KJV)

And when they had this done, they enclosed a great multitude of fishes: and their net brake.

Luke 5:7 (KJV)

And they beckoned unto [their] partners, which were in the other ship, that they should come and help them. And they came, and filled both the ships, so that they began to sink.

The land of Zabulon, and the land of Nephthalim, [by] the way of the sea, beyond Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles;

Matthew 4:16 (KJV)

The people which sat in darkness saw great light; and to them which sat in the region and shadow of death light is sprung up.

Let's continue in our book Desire of Ages, Chapter #25, page 244 - 246

Day was breaking over the Sea of Galilee. The disciples, weary with a night of fruitless toil, were still in their fishing boats on the lake. Jesus had come to spend a quiet hour by the waterside. In the early morning He hoped for a little season of rest from the multitude that followed Him day after day. But soon the people began to gather about Him. Their numbers rapidly increased, so that He was pressed upon all sides. Meanwhile the disciples had come to land. In order to escape the pressure of the multitude, Jesus stepped into Peter's boat, and bade him pull out a little from the shore. Here Jesus could be better seen and heard by all, and from the boat He taught the multitude on the beach. {DA 244.1}

What a scene was this for angels to contemplate; their glorious Commander, sitting in a fisherman's boat, swayed to and fro by the restless waves, and proclaiming the good news of salvation to the listening throng that were pressing down to the water's edge! He who was the Honored of heaven was declaring the great things of His kingdom in the open air, to the common people. Yet He could have had no more fitting scene for His labors. The lake, the mountains, the spreading fields, the sunlight flooding the earth, all furnished objects to illustrate His lessons and impress them upon the mind. And no lesson of Christ's fell fruitless. Every message from His lips came to some soul as the word of eternal life. {DA 244.2}

Question: From where did Jesus teach the multitude on the beach? And, what furnished objects were the more fitting scene for His labors, that Jesus used to illustrate His lessons and impress them upon the minds?

Answer: Jesus stepped into Peter's boat, and bade him pull out a little from the shore. And, in the open air the lake, the mountains, the spreading fields, the sunlight flooding the earth He was declaring the great things of His kingdom.

Every moment added to the multitude upon the shore. Aged men leaning upon their staffs, hardy peasants from the hills, fishermen from their toil on the lake, merchants and rabbis, the rich and learned, old and young, bringing their sick and suffering ones, pressed to hear the words of the divine Teacher. To such scenes as this the prophets had looked forward, and they wrote:

"The land of Zabulon, and the land of Nephthalim,
[by] the way of the sea, beyond Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles;
The people which sat in darkness saw great light;
and to them which sat in the region and shadow of death light is sprung up." {DA 245.1}

Beside the throng on the shores of Gennesaret, Jesus in His sermon by the sea had other audiences before His mind. Looking down the ages, He saw His faithful ones in prison and judgment hall, in temptation and loneliness and affliction. Every scene of joy and conflict and perplexity was open before Him. In the words spoken to those gathered about Him, He was speaking also to these other souls the very words that would come to them as a message of hope in trial, of comfort in sorrow, and heavenly light in darkness. Through the Holy Spirit, that voice which was speaking from the fisherman's boat on the Sea of Galilee, would be heard speaking peace to human hearts to the close of time. {DA 245.2}

Question: Who were among the vast multitude upon the shore that came to see and hear Jesus? And what other audiences did He have before His mind at the sermon by the sea shores of Gennesaret?

Answer: Aged men leaning upon their staffs, hardy peasants from the hills, fishermen from their toil on the lake, merchants and rabbis, the rich and learned, old and young, bringing their sick and suffering ones, pressed to hear the words of the divine Teacher. And, He had the faithful ones in prison and judgment hall, in temptation and loneliness and affliction.

Song: *Let's lean another beautiful scripture song dear one from the **book of Hebrews!***

Hebrews 7:25 (KJV)

Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.

The discourse ended, Jesus turned to Peter, and bade him launch out into the sea, and let down his net for a draught. But Peter was disheartened. All night he had taken nothing. During the lonely hours he had thought of the fate of John the Baptist, who was languishing alone in his dungeon. He had thought of the prospect before Jesus and His followers, of the ill success of the mission to Judea, and the malice of the priests and rabbis. Even his own occupation had failed him; and as he watched by the empty nets, the future had seemed dark with discouragement. "Master," he said, "we have toiled all the night, and have taken nothing: nevertheless at Thy word I will let down the net." {DA 245.3}

Question: Why was Peter disheartened when, Jesus turned and bade him launch out into the sea, and let down his net for a draught? And, during the lonely hours what was his thought upon?

Answer: Because all night he had taken nothing. And, he had thought of the fate of John the Baptist, who was languishing alone in his dungeon. He had thought of the prospect before Jesus and His followers, of the ill success of the mission to Judea, and the malice of the priests and rabbis.

Song: *Let's learn a beautiful scripture song dear one from the **book of 1 Corinthians!***

1 Corinthians 10:13 (KJV)

There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God [is] faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear [it].

Night was the only favorable time for fishing with nets in the clear waters of the lake. After toiling all night without success, it seemed hopeless to cast the net by day; but Jesus had given the command, and love for their Master moved the disciples to obey. Simon and his brother together let down the net. As they attempted to draw it in, so great was the quantity of fish enclosed that it began to break. They were obliged to summon James and John to their aid. When the catch was secured, both the boats were so heavily laden that they were in danger of sinking. {DA 246.1}

Question: What moved the disciples to obey Jesus' command to cast the net by day after toiling all night?

Answer: Their love for their Master. Simon and his brother together let down the net. As they attempted to draw it in, so great was the quantity of fish enclosed that it began to break.

Hebrews 11:6 (KJV)

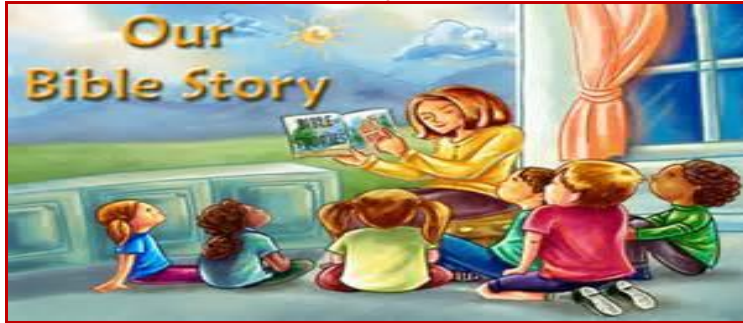
But without faith [it is] impossible to please [him]:
for he that cometh to God must believe that he is,
and [that] he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

But Peter was unmindful now of boats or lading. This miracle, above any other he had ever witnessed, was to him a manifestation of divine power. In Jesus he saw One who held all nature under His control. The presence of divinity revealed his own unholiness. Love for his Master, shame for his own unbelief, gratitude for the condescension of Christ, above all, the sense of his uncleanness in the presence of infinite purity, overwhelmed him. While his companions were securing the contents of the net, Peter fell at the Saviour's feet, exclaiming, "Depart from me; for I am a sinful man, O Lord." {DA 246.2}

Question: What was this miracle for Peter, above any other had he ever witnessed? And, what did he see in Jesus?

Answer: It was to him a manifestation of divine power. And, One who held all nature under His control.

How man can be a **counterpart** of Jesus Christ is beyond human **comprehension**. But the Holy Spirit can strengthen our spiritual eyesight, enabling us to see what our natural eyes cannot see, or our ears hear, or our minds **comprehend**. By the Spirit which searches all things, even the deep things of God, have been revealed precious truths which cannot be described by pen or voice. {SD 34.2}

In all who will submit themselves to the Holy Spirit a new principle of life is to be **implanted**; the lost image of God is to be restored in humanity. {SD 34.3}

But man can not **transform** himself by the exercise of his will. He possesses no power by which this change can be effected. The leaven --something wholly from without--must be put into the meal before the desired change can be wrought in it. So the grace of God must be received by the sinner before he can be fitted for the kingdom of glory. All the culture and education which the world can give, will fail of making a **degraded** child of sin a child of heaven. The renewing energy must come from God. The change can be made only by the Holy Spirit. All who would be saved, high or low, rich or poor, must submit to the working of this power. {SD 34.4}

Every heart that has been visited by the bright **beams** of the Sun of Righteousness will reveal the working of the Spirit of God in voice, mind, and character. The **machinery** will move as if oiled and guided by a **masterly** hand. There will be less friction when the spirit of the worker receives the oil from the two olive branches. The holy influences will be **imparted** to others in words of kindness, tenderness, love, and encouragement. {SD 34.5}

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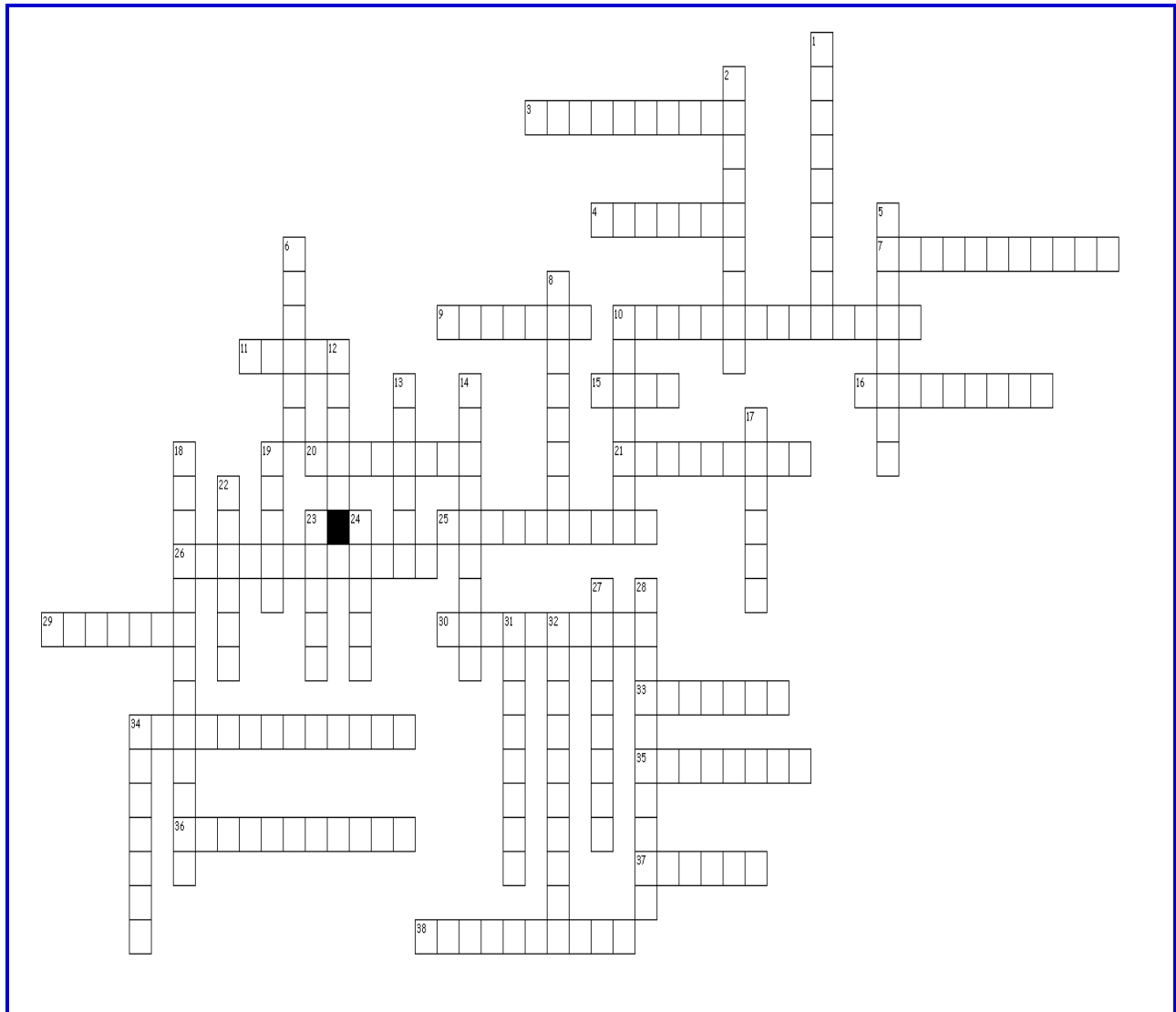
