Lesson #160: “Who Are my Brethren?” Part 3

Matthew 12:44 (KJV)

Then he saith, I will return into my house from whence I came out; and when he is come, he findeth [it] empty, swept, and garnished.

*This week boys and girls, we will continue with Part 3 in our lesson entitle,
 “Who Are my Brethren?” in our study book Desire of Ages!*

Matthew 12:45 (KJV)

Then goeth he, and taketh with himself seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and they enter in and dwell there: and the last [state] of that man is worse than the first. Even so shall it be also unto this wicked generation.

Matthew 12:46 (KJV)

While he yet talked to the people, behold, [his] mother and his brethren stood without, desiring to speak with him.

Matthew 12:47 (KJV)

Then one said unto him, Behold, thy mother and thy brethren stand without, desiring to speak with thee.

Matthew 12:48 (KJV)

But he answered and said unto him that told him, Who is my mother? and who are my brethren?

Matthew 12:49 (KJV)

And he stretched forth his hand toward his disciples, and said, Behold my mother and my brethren!

Matthew 12:50 (KJV)

For whosoever shall do the will of my Father which is in heaven, the same is my brother, and sister, and mother.

Let's continue in our book Desire of Ages, Chapter #33, pages 324 – 326

“The last state of that man is worse than the first. Even so,” said Jesus, “shall it be also unto this wicked generation.” There are none so hardened as those who have slighted the invitation of mercy, and done despite to the Spirit of grace. The most common manifestation of the sin against the Holy Spirit is in persistently slighting Heaven's invitation to repent. Every step in the rejection of Christ is a step toward the rejection of salvation, and toward the sin against the Holy Spirit. {DA 324.2}

Question: Whose hearts are the most hardened, and what do they refuse? And, what does every step in the rejection of Christ lead to?

Answer: There are none so hardened as those who have slighted the invitation of mercy, and done despite to the Spirit of grace. And, every step in the rejection of Christ is a step toward the rejection of salvation, and toward the sin against the Holy Spirit.

In rejecting Christ the Jewish people committed the unpardonable sin; and by refusing the invitation of mercy, we may commit the same error. We offer insult to the Prince of life, and put Him to shame before the synagogue of Satan and before the heavenly universe when we refuse to listen to His delegated messengers, and instead listen to the agents of Satan, who would draw the soul away from Christ. So long as one does this, he can find no hope or pardon, and he will finally lose all desire to be reconciled to God. {DA 324.3}

Question: What did the Jewish people commit in rejecting Christ? And, what happens when we refuse to listen to His delegated messengers, and instead listen to the agents of Satan, who draw the soul away from Christ?

Answer: They committed the unpardonable sin by refusing the invitation of mercy. And, we offer insult to the Prince of life, and put Him to shame before the synagogue of Satan and before the heavenly universe.

John 1:1-5, 9-11(KJV)

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God,

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was God.

The same was in the beginning with God.

All things were made by him;

and without him was not any thing made that was made.

In him was life; and the life was the light

(the life was the light of men.)

And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.

[That] was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not.

He came unto his own, and his own received him not. (2 xs)

John chapter 1 verses 1 through 5 and 9 through 11

While Jesus was still teaching the people, His disciples brought the message that His mother and His brothers were without, and desired to see Him. He knew what was in their hearts, and “He answered and said unto him that told Him, Who is My mother? and who are My brethren? And He stretched forth His hand toward His disciples, and said, Behold My mother and My brethren! For whosoever shall do the will of My Father which is in heaven, the same is My brother, and sister, and mother.” {DA 325.1}

Question: How did Jesus answer the disciple that told Him the message that His mother and His brothers were without, and desired to see Him? And, who did He stretched forth His hand toward and what did he said?

Answer: “Who is My mother? and who are My brethren?” And, He stretched forth His hand toward His disciples, and said, Behold My mother and My brethren!

All who would receive Christ by faith were united to Him by a tie closer than that of human kinship. They would become one with Him, as He was one with the Father. As a believer and doer of His words, His mother was more nearly and savingly related to Him than through her natural relationship. His brothers would receive no benefit from their connection with Him unless they accepted Him as their personal Saviour. {DA 325.2}

Question: What will happen to all who would receive Christ by faith? And, does Jesus’ brothers received any benefit from their connection with Him?

Answer: They were united to Him by a tie closer than that of human kinship; they would become one with Him, as He was one with the Father. And, No! They did not benefit by their connection with Him unless they accepted Him as their personal Saviour.

Philippians 2: 5-11 (KJV)

Let this mind be in you,
which was also in Christ Jesus:
Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:
But made himself of no reputation,
and took upon him the form of a servant,
and was made in the likeness of men: (2 xs)
And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself,
and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.
Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him,
and given him a name which is above every name:
That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow,
of [things] in heaven, and [things] in earth, and [things] under the earth;
And [that] every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ [is] Lord,
to the glory of God the Father.
Philippians chapter 2 verses 5 through 11

What a support Christ would have found in His earthly relatives if they had believed in Him as one from heaven, and had co-operated with Him in doing the work of God! Their unbelief cast a shadow over the earthly life of Jesus. It was a part of the bitterness of that cup of woe which He drained for us. {DA 325.3}

Question: What did Christ suffer by the lack of support found in His earthly relatives? And, what did it become in His work?

Answer: Their unbelief cast a shadow over the earthly life of Jesus. It was a part of the bitterness of that cup of woe which He drained for us.

The enmity kindled in the human heart against the gospel was keenly felt by the Son of God, and it was most painful to Him in His home; for His own heart was full of kindness and love, and He appreciated tender regard in the family relation. His brothers desired that He should concede to their ideas, when such a course would have been utterly out of harmony with His divine mission. They looked upon Him as in need of their counsel. They judged Him from their human point of view, and thought that if He would speak only such things as would be acceptable to the scribes and Pharisees, He would avoid the disagreeable controversy that His words aroused. They thought that He was beside Himself in claiming divine authority, and in placing Himself before the rabbis as a reprover of their sins. They knew that the Pharisees were seeking occasion to accuse Him, and they felt that He had given them sufficient occasion. {DA 326.1}

Question: What was keenly felt by the Son of God against the gospel? And, what were the ideas His brothers had about Him that was utterly out of harmony with His divine mission?

Answer: The enmity kindled in the human heart. It was most painful to Him in His home; for His own heart was full of kindness and love, and He appreciated tender regard in the family relation. And, they looked upon Him as in need of their counsel, they judged Him from their human point of view, and thought that if He would speak only such things as would be acceptable to the scribes and Pharisees.

Chapter 3-We Enter Into Christ's Rest
Narrated by our dear Brother Graves!

There remaineth therefore a rest to the people of God. Hebrews 4:9. {SD 76.1}

If you are willing to learn **meekness** and **lowliness** of heart in Christ's school, He will surely give you rest and peace. It is a terribly hard struggle to give up your own will and your own way. But this lesson learned, you will find rest and peace. Pride, **selfishness**, and **ambition**, must be overcome; your will must be swallowed up in the will of Christ. The whole life may become one constant love sacrifice, every action a **manifestation**, and every word an **utterance** of love. As the life of the vine circulates through stem and cluster, descends into the lower **fibres**, and reaches to the topmost leaf, so will the grace and love of Christ burn and abound in the soul, sending its virtues to every part of the being, and pervading every exercise of body and mind. {SD 76.2}

In being **co-workers** with Christ in the great work for which He gave His life, we shall find true rest. When we were sinners, He gave His life for us. He wants us to come to Him and learn of Him. Thus we are to find rest. He says He will give us rest. "Learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart." In doing this you will find in your own experience the rest that Christ gives, the rest that comes from wearing His yoke and lifting His burdens. {SD 76.3}

A form of **godliness** without the power is a weariness and burden; but when the whole heart is enlisted in the service of Christ, there is rest to the soul; for God causeth such to **triumph** daily over the powers of darkness. God helps him who commits his soul unto the Lord as unto a faithful Creator. {SD 76.4}

To learn the lessons Christ teaches is the greatest treasure students can find. Rest comes to them in the consciousness that they are trying to please the Lord. {SD 76.5}

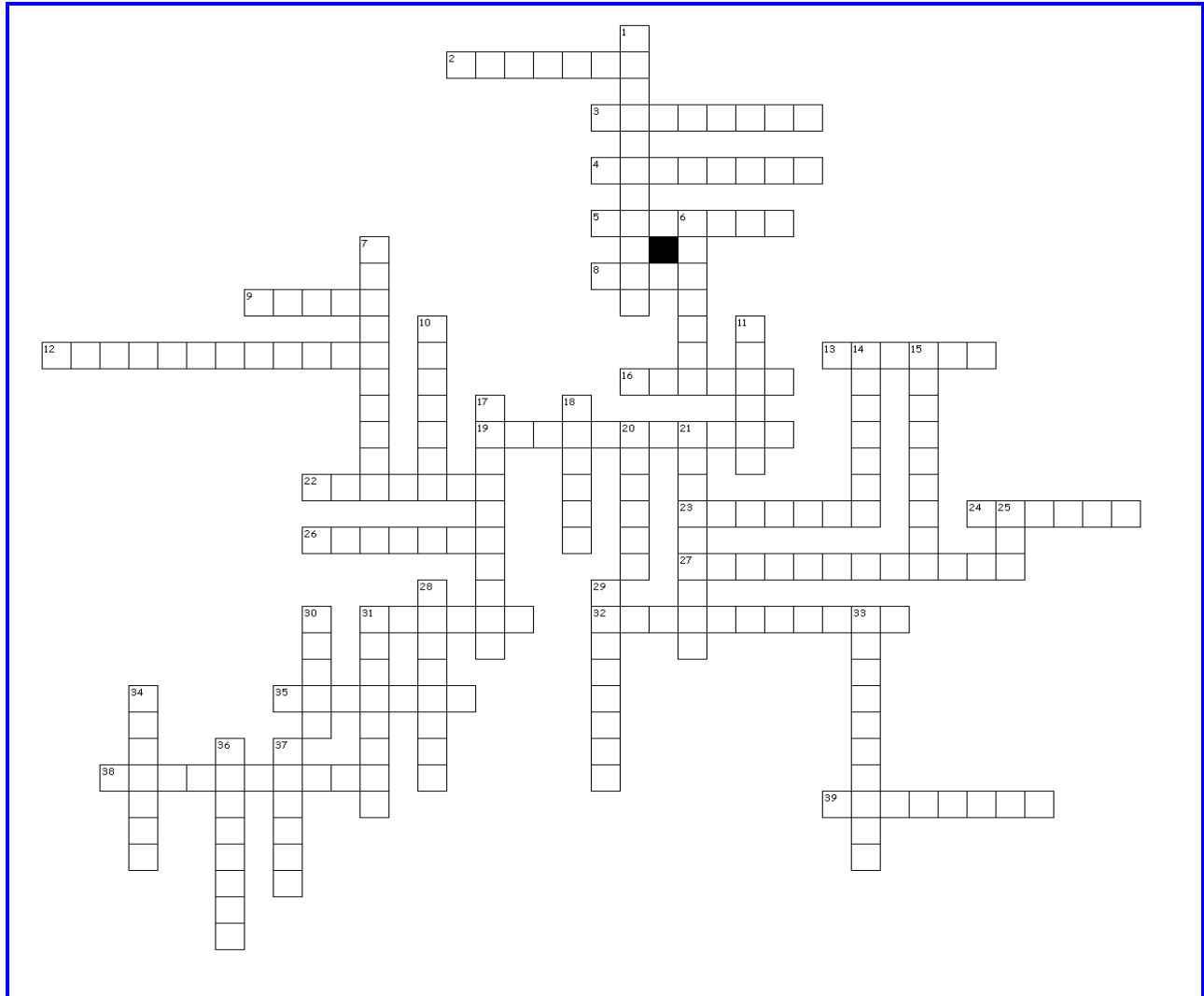
