There are many whose hearts are aching under a load of care because they seek to reach the world's standard. They have chosen its service, accepted its perplexities, adopted its customs. Thus their character is marred, and their life made a weariness. In order to gratify ambition and worldly desires, they wound the conscience, and bring upon themselves an additional burden of remorse. The continual worry is wearing out the life forces. Our Lord desires them to lay aside this yoke of bondage. He invites them to accept His yoke; He says, "My yoke is easy, and My burden is light." He bids them seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and His promise is that all things needful to them for this life shall be added. Worry is blind, and cannot discern the future; but Jesus sees the end from the beginning. In every difficulty He has His way prepared to bring relief. Our heavenly Father has a thousand ways to provide for us, of which we know nothing. Those who accept the one principle of making the service and honor of God supreme will find perplexities vanish, and a plain path before their feet. {DA 330.1}

**Question:** Why are there many whose hearts are aching under a load of care? And, what does the Saviour bid us to seek first and what will be added to their life?

**Answer:** Because they seek to reach the world's standard. They have chosen its service, accepted its perplexities, adopted its customs. And, He bids them seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and His promise is that all things needful to them for this life shall be added.

**Question:** What will those who accept the one principle of making the service and honor of God supreme, find?

**Answer:** They will find perplexities vanish, and a plain path before their feet.

“Learn of Me,” says Jesus; “for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest.” We are to enter the school of Christ, to learn from Him meekness and lowliness. Redemption is that process by which the soul is trained for heaven. This training means a knowledge of Christ. It means emancipation from ideas, habits, and practices that have been gained in the school of the prince of darkness. The soul must be delivered from all that is opposed to loyalty to God. {DA 330.2}

**Question:** Why did Jesus say we must learn of Him? And, what is the process of redemption by which the soul is trained for heaven?

**Answer:** He said, “for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest.” To learn from Him meekness and lowliness for He is meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest. And, It means a knowledge of Christ as well as emancipation from ideas, habits, and practices that have been gained in the school of the prince of darkness.

In the heart of Christ, where reigned perfect harmony with God, there was perfect peace. He was never elated by applause, nor dejected by censure or disappointment. Amid the greatest opposition and the most cruel treatment, He was still of good courage. But many who profess to be His followers have an anxious, troubled heart, because they are afraid to trust themselves with God. They do not make a complete surrender to Him; for they shrink from the consequences that such a surrender may involve. Unless they do make this surrender, they cannot find peace. {DA 330.3}

**Question:** What was in the heart of Christ that led to perfect harmony with God?

**Answer:** There was perfect peace. He was never elated by applause, nor dejected by censure or disappointment. Amid the greatest opposition and the most cruel treatment, He was still of good courage.

It is the love of self that brings unrest. When we are born from above, the same mind will be in us that was in Jesus, the mind that led Him to humble Himself that we might be saved. Then we shall not be seeking the highest place. We shall desire to sit at the feet of Jesus, and learn of Him. We shall understand that the value of our work does not consist in making a show and noise in the world, and in being active and zealous in our own strength. The value of our work is in proportion to the impartation of the Holy Spirit. Trust in God brings holier qualities of mind, so that in patience we may possess our souls. {DA 330.4}

**Question:** What brings us an unrest of mind? And, what does Trust in God brings us?

**Answer:** It is the love of self. And it will bring holier qualities of mind, so that in patience we may possess our souls.

The yoke is placed upon the oxen to aid them in drawing the load, to lighten the burden. So with the yoke of Christ. When our will is swallowed up in the will of God, and we use His gifts to bless others, we shall find life's burden light. He who walks in the way of God's commandments is walking in company with Christ, and in His love the heart is at rest. When Moses prayed, "Show me now Thy way, that I may know Thee," the Lord answered him, "My presence shall go with thee, and I will give thee rest." And through the prophets the message was given, "Thus saith the Lord, Stand ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and walk therein, and ye shall find rest for your souls." **Exodus 33:13, 14; Jeremiah 6:16.** And He says, "O that thou hadst hearkened to My commandments! then had thy peace been as a river, and thy righteousness as the waves of the sea." **Isaiah 48:18. {DA 331.1}**

**Question:** How shall we find life's burden lightened? And, in whose company are they who walk in the way of God's commandments, and what shall their heart find in His love?

**Answer:** When our will is swallowed up in the will of God, and we use His gifts to bless others. And, in company with Christ, and in His love the heart is at rest.

Satan still comes with his temptations to the children of men. He employs every means at his command to conceal himself from view, and this is why so many are ignorant of his devices. A few days since, the question was asked me, "Do you believe in a personal devil?" "I do," was the answer. "Well," rejoined the questioner, "I do not believe that there is any such being; our evil thoughts and **impulses** are all the devil we know anything about!" "But," I asked, "who suggests these thoughts? Whence do they **originate**, if not from Satan?" . . . {SD 79.2}

Just as surely as we have a personal Saviour, we have also a personal **adversary**, cruel and cunning, who ever watches our steps, and plots to lead us astray. He can work most effectually in **disguise**. Wherever the opinion is entertained that he does not exist, there he is most busy. When we least suspect his presence, he is gaining advantage over us. I feel alarmed as I see so many of the youth yielding to his power while they know it not. Did they but see their danger, they would flee to Christ, the sinner's refuge. {SD 79.3}

**Aim** to be faithful students in the school of Christ, learning daily to conform your life to the divine Pattern. Set your faces heavenward, and press toward the mark for the prize of your high calling in Christ Jesus. Run the Christian race with **patience**, and rise superior to every **temptation**, however grievous it may be, that shall come to you. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw nigh to God; and if you are **desirous** of taking the first upward step, you will find His hand stretched out to help you. It remains with you, individually, as to whether you walk in the light of the Sun of Righteousness, or in the darkness of error. The truth of God can be a blessing to you only as you permit its **influence** to purify and **refine** your soul. {SD 79.4}

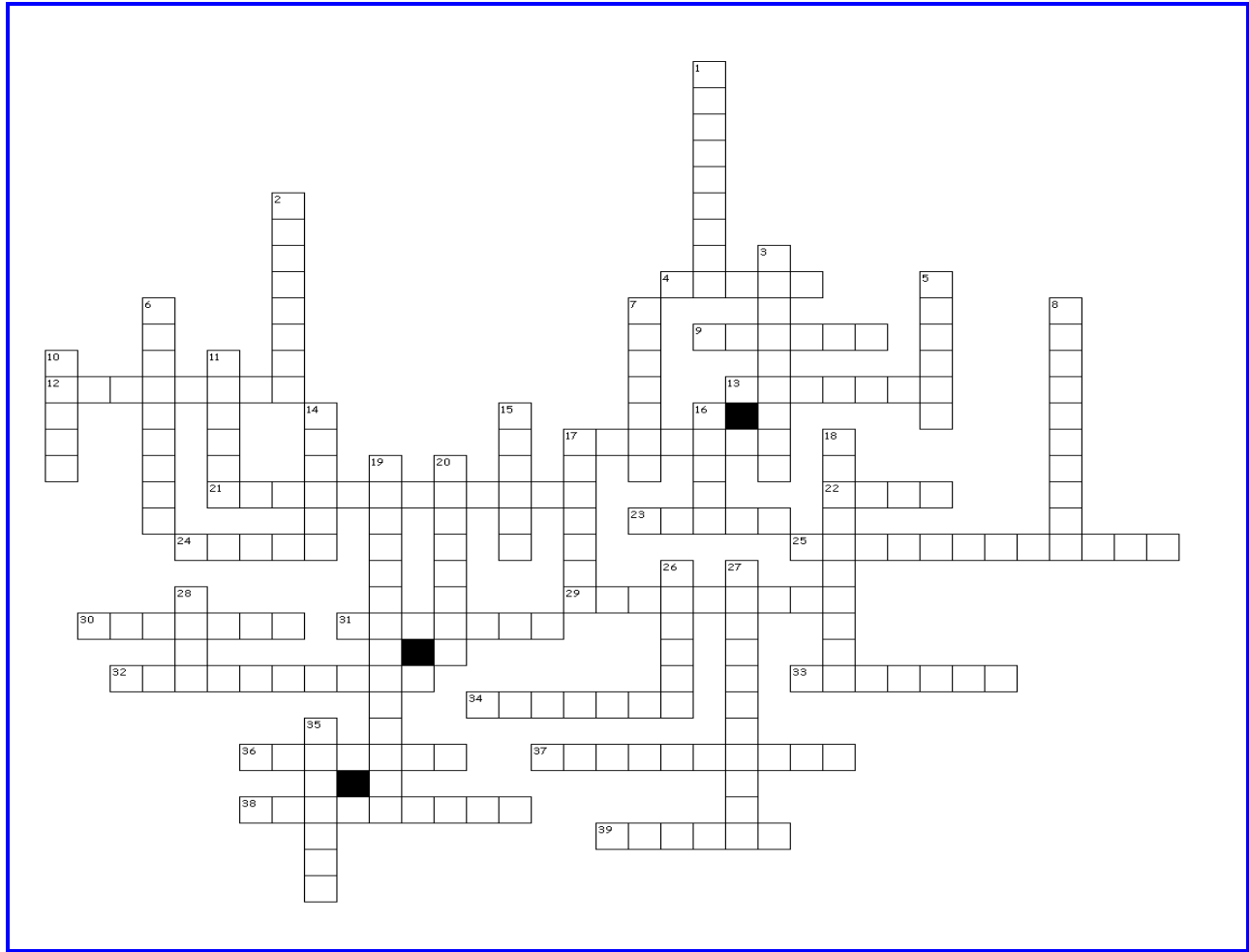
