***Lesson #164: “The Invention” Part 3***

**Isaiah 26:3 (KJV)**

**Thou wilt keep [him] in perfect peace, [whose] mind [is] stayed [on thee]: because he trusteth in thee.**

**Let's continue in our book Desire of Ages, Chapter #34, pages 331**

Those who take Christ at His word, and surrender their souls to His keeping, their lives to His ordering, will find peace and quietude. Nothing of the world can make them sad when Jesus makes them glad by His presence. In perfect acquiescence there is perfect rest. The Lord says, "Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on Thee: because he trusteth in Thee." **Isaiah 26:3.**

**Question:** Who will find peace and quietude in their lives to the ordered of Jesus? And, what did the Lord say to the ones who trusteth in Him?

**Answer:** Those who take Christ at His word, and surrender their souls to His keeping. And, "Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on Thee: because he trusteth in Thee."

**Continuing:** Our lives may seem a tangle; but as we commit ourselves to the wise Master Worker, He will bring out the pattern of life and character that will be to His own glory. And that character which expresses the glory--character--of Christ will be received into the Paradise of God. A renovated race shall walk with Him in white, for they are worthy. **{DA 331.2}**

**Question:** What will happen if we commit ourselves to the wise Master Worker? And, where will they be received express the glory—character—of Christ?

**Answer:** He (Jesus) will bring out the pattern of life and character that will be to His own glory. And, they will be received into the Paradise of God.

As through Jesus we enter into rest, heaven begins here. We respond to His invitation, Come, learn of Me, and in thus coming we begin the life eternal. Heaven is a ceaseless approaching to God through Christ. The longer we are in the heaven of bliss, the more and still more of glory will be opened to us; and the more we know of God, the more intense will be our happiness.

**Question:** What is Heaven and where does it begins? And, through whom can we make it there?

**Answer:** Heaven begins here; we respond to His invitation, Come, learn of Me, and in thus coming we begin the life eternal. Heaven is a ceaseless approaching to God through Christ.

**Continuing:** As we walk with Jesus in this life, we may be filled with His love, satisfied with His presence. All that human nature can bear, we may receive here. But what is this compared with the hereafter? There “are they before the throne of God, and serve Him day and night in His temple: and He that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them.

**Question:** What will happen as we walk with Jesus in this life? And, what shall be in the hereafter for those who are filled with His love that is beyond compare?

**Answer:** We may be filled with His love, satisfied with His presence. And, there “are they before the throne of God, and serve Him day and night in His temple: and He that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them.

Once he survives the night, he is a MAN. He cannot tell the other boys of this experience, because each lad must come into manhood on his own. The boy is naturally terrified. He can hear all kinds of noises. Wild beasts must surely be all around him. Maybe even some human might do him harm. The wind blew the grass and earth, and shook his stump, but he sat stoically, never removing the blindfold. It would be the only way he could become a man! Finally, after a horrific night the sun appeared and he removed his blindfold. It was then that he discovered his father sitting on the stump next to him. He had been on watch the entire night, protecting his son from harm. We, too, are never alone.

Even when we don't know it, God is watching over us; Sitting on the stump beside us. When trouble comes, all we have to do is reach out to Him. If you liked this story, pass it on. If not, you took off your blindfold before dawn. Moral of the story: Just because you can't see God, Doesn't mean He is not there. "For we walk by faith, not by sight!!!

Chapter 3-To Be Loving and Kind  
Let brotherly love continue. Hebrews 13:1. {SD 80.1}

No member of the family can inclose himself within himself. . . . If he is filled with the love of Christ, he will manifest courtesy, kindness, tender regard for the feelings of others, and will communicate to his **associates**, by his acts of love, a tender, grateful, happy feeling. It will be made manifest that he is living for Jesus, and daily learning lessons at His feet, receiving His light and His peace. {SD 80.2}

The most careful cultivation of the outward proprieties of life is not sufficient to shut out all **fretfulness**, harsh judgment, and **unbecoming** speech. True refinement will never be revealed so long as self is considered as the supreme object. Love must dwell in the heart. A thoroughgoing Christian draws his motives of action from his deep heart-love for his Master. Up through the roots of his affection for Christ springs an **unselfish** interest in his brethren. {SD 80.3}

Of all things that are sought, cherished, and cultivated, there is nothing so valuable in the sight of God as a pure heart, a **disposition imbued** with thankfulness and peace. {SD 80.4}

If the divine harmony of truth and love exists in the heart, it will shine forth in words and actions.... The spirit of genuine benevolence must dwell in the heart. Love imparts to its possessor grace, **propriety**, and comeliness of deportment. Love **illuminates** the countenance and **subdues** the voice; it refines and elevates the entire man. It brings him into harmony with God, for it is a heavenly attribute. {SD 80.5}

Allow no selfishness to live in the heart or find room in the home.... When all are members of the royal family, there will be true **politeness** in the home life. Each member of the family will seek to make it pleasant for every other member. {SD 80.6}.

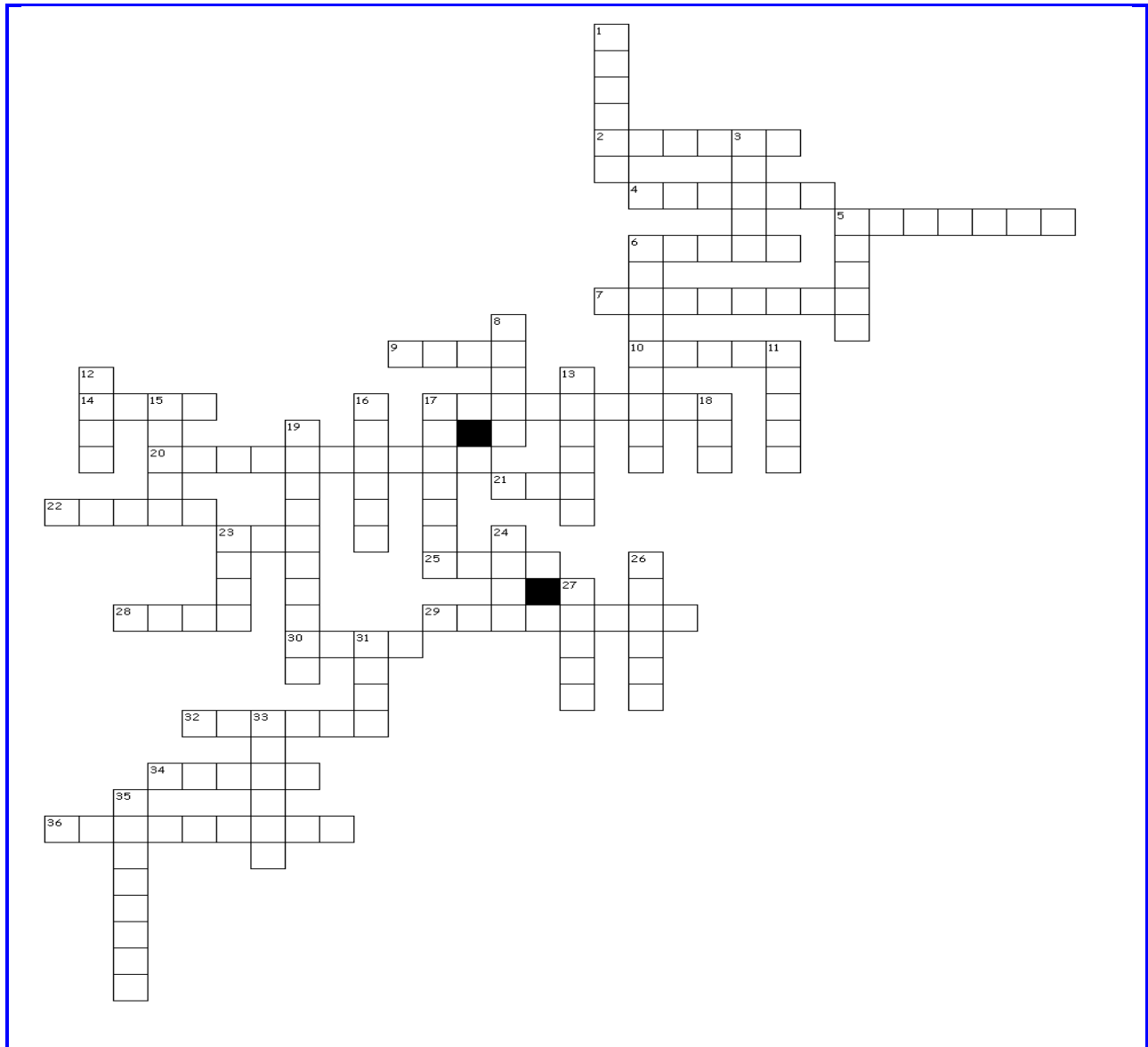
