Lesson #171: “The Touch of Faith” Part 2

Matthew 9:20 (KJV)

And, behold, a woman, which was diseased with an issue of blood twelve years, came behind [him], and touched the hem of his garment:

*This Sabbath boys and girls, we will continue with Part 2 of our lesson entitle,
“The Touch of Faith” in our study book Desire of Ages!*

Luke 8:43 (KJV)

And a woman having an issue of blood twelve years, which had spent all her living upon physicians, neither could be healed of any,

Luke 8:44 (KJV)

Came behind [him], and touched the border of his garment: and immediately her issue of blood stanchd.

Luke 8:45 (KJV)

And Jesus said, Who touched me? When all denied, Peter and they that were with him said, Master, the multitude throng thee and press [thee], and sayest thou, Who touched me?

And Jesus said, Somebody hath touched me: for I perceive that virtue is gone out of me.

And when the woman saw that she was not hid, she came trembling, and falling down before him, she declared unto him before all the people for what cause she had touched him, and how she was healed immediately.

Matthew 9:22 (KJV)

But Jesus turned him about, and when he saw her, he said, Daughter, be of good comfort; thy faith hath made thee whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour.

Let's continue in our book Desire of Ages, Chapter #36, pages 343-347

The golden opportunity had come. She was in the presence of the Great Physician! But amid the confusion she could not speak to Him, nor catch more than a passing glimpse of His figure. Fearful of losing her one chance of relief, she pressed forward, saying to herself, "If I may but touch His garment, I shall be whole." As He was passing, she reached forward, and succeeded in barely touching the border of His garment. But in that moment she knew that she was healed. In that one touch was concentrated the faith of her life, and instantly her pain and feebleness gave place to the vigor of perfect health. {DA 343.5}

Question: What did the woman do regardless being fearful of losing her one chance of relief? And, what lead her to believe in that moment she knew that she was healed in barely touching the border of His garment?

Answer: She pressed forward, saying to herself, "If I may but touch His garment, I shall be whole." And, In that one touch was concentrated the faith of her life, and instantly her pain and feebleness gave place to the vigor of perfect health.

With a grateful heart she then tried to withdraw from the crowd; but suddenly Jesus stopped, and the people halted with Him. He turned, and looking about asked in a voice distinctly heard above the confusion of the multitude, "Who touched Me?" The people answered this query with a look of amazement. Jostled upon all sides, and rudely pressed hither and thither, as He was, it seemed a strange inquiry. {DA 344.1}

Question: What did the woman do after her healing? And, what was Jesus' reaction after her healing by touching His garment?

Answer: With a grateful heart she then tried to withdraw from the crowd. And, suddenly Jesus stopped, and the people halted with Him. He turned, and looking about asked in a voice distinctly heard above the confusion of the multitude, "Who touched Me?"

Song: *Let's learn another beautiful scripture song dear one, from the book of Acts!*

Acts 17:27 (KJV)

That they should seek the Lord, if haply
they might feel after him,
and find him,
though he be not far from every one of us:

Peter, ever ready to speak, said, "Master, the multitude throng Thee and press Thee, and sayest Thou, Who touched Me?" Jesus answered, "Somebody hath touched Me: for I perceive that virtue is gone out of Me." The Saviour could distinguish the touch of faith from the casual contact of the careless throng. Such trust should not be passed without comment. He would speak to the humble woman words of comfort that would be to her a wellspring of joy,--words that would be a blessing to His followers to the close of time. {DA 344.2}

Question: What had gone out of the Master (Jesus) after the woman touched Him? And, what can the Saviour distinguish by the touch?

Answer: He had asked, "Who touched Me?" For He perceive that virtue is gone out of Him. And, the touch of faith from the casual contact of the careless throng for such trust should not be passed without comment.

Looking toward the woman, Jesus insisted on knowing who had touched Him. Finding concealment vain, she came forward tremblingly, and cast herself at His feet. With grateful tears she told the story of her suffering, and how she had found relief. Jesus gently said, "Daughter, be of good comfort: thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace." He gave no opportunity for superstition to claim healing virtue for the mere act of touching His garments. It was not through the outward contact with Him, but through the faith which took hold on His divine power, that the cure was wrought. {DA 344.3}

Question: What did Jesus say to the woman after she came forward tremblingly, casting herself at His feet with grateful tears telling her story of her suffering? And, was the healing virtue brought through the outward contact with Jesus?

Answer: Jesus gently said, "Daughter, be of good comfort: thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace." And, No! But through the faith which took hold on His divine power, that the cure was wrought.

Song: *Let's learn yet another beautiful scripture song dear one, from the book of 1 Corinthians!*

1 Corinthians 10:11 (KJV)

Now all these things happened unto them for ensamples:
and they are written for our admonition,
upon whom the ends of the world are come.
1 Corinthians chapter 10 verse 11 (2 xs)

The wondering crowd that pressed close about Christ realized no accession of vital power. But when the suffering woman put forth her hand to touch Him, believing that she would be made whole, she felt the healing virtue. So in spiritual things. To talk of religion in a casual way, to pray without soul hunger and living faith, avails nothing. A nominal faith in Christ, which accepts Him merely as the Saviour of the world, can never bring healing to the soul. The faith that is unto salvation is not a mere intellectual assent to the truth. He who waits for entire knowledge before he will exercise faith, cannot receive blessing from God. It is not enough to believe about Christ; we must believe in Him.

Question: And, what will avail to nothing in the spiritual things as with the healing virtue of Jesus in the soul without faith? And, what can never bring healing to the soul?

Answer: To talk of religion in a casual way, to pray without soul hunger and living faith. And, a nominal faith in Christ, which accepts Him merely as the Saviour of the world; the faith that is unto salvation is not a mere intellectual assent to the truth. He who waits for entire knowledge before he will exercise faith, cannot receive blessing from God.

Continuing: The only faith that will benefit us is that which embraces Him as a personal Saviour; which appropriates His merits to ourselves. Many hold faith as an opinion. Saving faith is a transaction by which those who receive Christ join themselves in covenant relation with God. Genuine faith is life. A living faith means an increase of vigor, a confiding trust, by which the soul becomes a conquering power. {DA 347.1}

Question: What is the only faith that will benefit us? And, what do many hold faith to be? And, what is, "Saving Faith?"

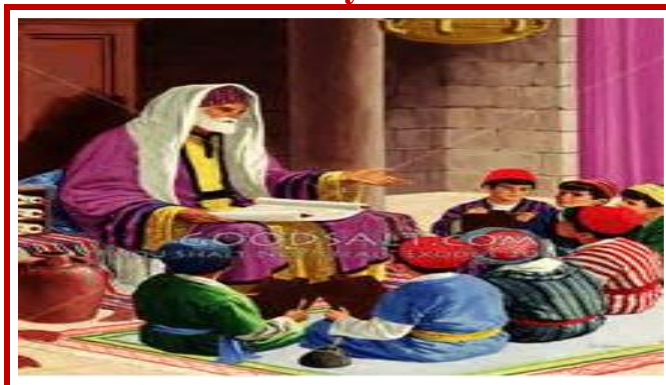
Answer: Is that which embraces Him as a personal Saviour; which appropriates His merits to ourselves. And, many hold faith as an opinion. Saving faith is a transaction by which those who receive Christ join themselves in covenant relation with God. Genuine faith is life.

Chapter 3-Steadfastness

For then shalt thou lift up thy face without spot; yea, thou shalt be stedfast, and shalt not fear. Job 11:15. {SD 87.1}

It is right for the youth to feel that they must reach the highest **development** of their mental powers. We would not restrict the education to which God has set no limit. But our **attainments** avail nothing if not put to use for the honor of God and the good of humanity. . . . {SD 87.2}

What we need is knowledge that will strengthen mind and soul, that will make us better men and women. Heart education is of far more importance than mere book-learning. It is well, even **essential**, to have a knowledge of the world in which we live; but if we leave eternity out of our reckoning, we shall make a failure from which we can never recover. . . . If the youth understood their own weakness, they would find in God their strength. {SD 87.3}

There is a science of Christianity to be mastered,--a science as much deeper, broader, higher than any human science as the heavens are higher than the earth. The mind is to be disciplined, educated, trained; for we are to do service for God in ways that are not in harmony with inborn **inclination**. **Hereditary** and **cultivated** tendencies to evil must be **overcome**. Often the education and training of a lifetime must be discarded, that one may become a learner in the school of Christ. Our hearts must be educated to become **steadfast** in God. We are to form habits of thought that will enable us to resist **temptation**. We must learn to look upward. The principles of the Word of God,--principles that are as high as heaven, and that compass eternity,--we are to understand in their bearing upon our daily life. Every act, every word, every thought, is to be in accord with these **principles**. All must be brought into harmony with, and subject to, Christ. {SD 87.4}

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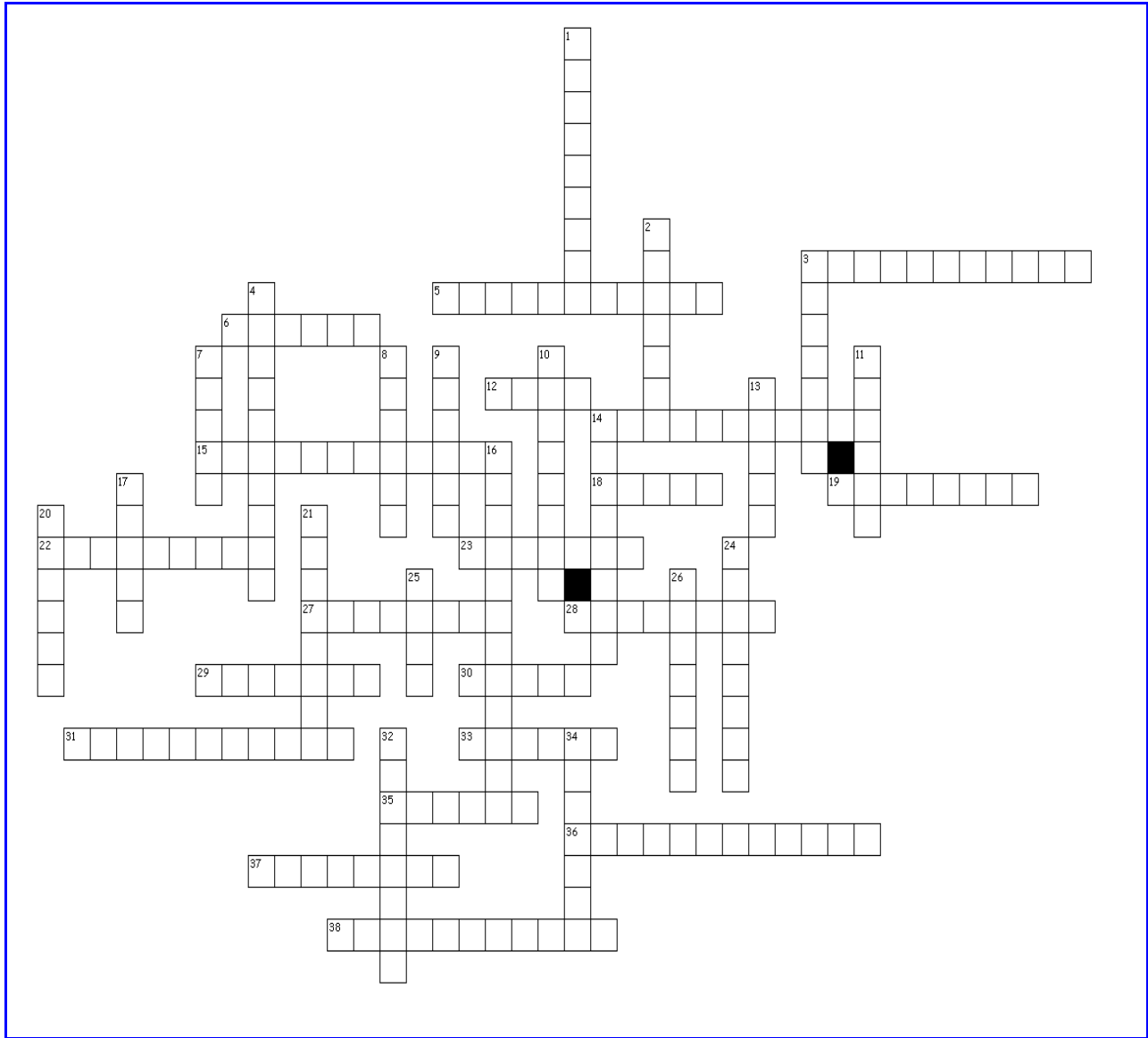
