Let's continue in our book Desire of Ages, Chapter #37, pages 350-352

Now the Saviour's eye penetrates the future; He beholds the broader fields in which, after His death, the disciples are to be witnesses for Him. His prophetic glance takes in the experience of His servants through all the ages till He shall come the second time. He shows His followers the conflicts they must meet; He reveals the character and plan of the battle. He lays open before them the perils they must encounter, the self-denial that will be required.

Question: What did the Saviour's penetrative eyes behold of the future that His disciples were to be witnesses for Him? And, what did He reveal to His servants regarding all the ages till He shall come the second time?

Answer: His prophetic glance takes in the experiences their conflicts, battles and perils they must meet. And, He reveals the character and plan of the battle and He lays open before them the perils they must encounter, the self-denial that will be required.

Philippians 2:5-11 (KJV)

Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:
Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:
But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant,
and was made in the likeness of men: (2 xs)
And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself,
and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.
Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:
That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of [things] in heaven,
and [things] in earth, and [things] under the earth;
And [that] **every tongue** should confess that Jesus Christ [is] Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:
Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:
But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant,
and was made in the likeness of men: (2 xs)
And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself,
and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.
Philippians Chapter 2 verses 5 through 11

Continuing: He desires them to count the cost, that they may not be taken unawares by the enemy. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high [places]. **Ephesians 6:12.** They are to contend with supernatural forces, but they are assured of supernatural help.

Continuing: All the intelligences of heaven are in this army. And more than angels are in the ranks. The Holy Spirit, the representative of the Captain of the Lord's host, comes down to direct the battle. Our infirmities may be many, our sins and mistakes grievous; but the grace of God is for all who seek it with contrition. The power of Omnipotence is enlisted in behalf of those who trust in God. {DA 352.2}

Question: How did Jesus desires them to count the cost that they may not be taken unawares by the enemy? And, who will be their supernatural helpers in this battle against principalities?

Answer: “For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, powers, rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high [places].” But they are assured of supernatural help; all the intelligences of heavens army, angels in the ranks and The Holy Spirit, the representative of the Captain of the Lord's host.

“Behold,” said Jesus, “I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.” Christ Himself did not suppress one word of truth, but He spoke it always in love. He exercised the greatest tact, and thoughtful, kind attention in His intercourse with the people.

Continuing: He was never rude, never needlessly spoke a severe word, never gave needless pain to a sensitive soul. He did not censure human weakness. He fearlessly denounced hypocrisy, unbelief, and iniquity, but tears were in His voice as He uttered His scathing rebukes. He wept over Jerusalem, the city He loved, that refused to receive Him, the Way, the Truth, and the Life.

Continuing: They rejected Him, the Saviour, but He regarded them with pitying tenderness, and sorrow so deep that it broke His heart. Every soul was precious in His eyes. While He always bore Himself with divine dignity, He bowed with tenderest regard to every member of the family of God. In all men He saw fallen souls whom it was His mission to save. {DA 353.1}

Question: How did Jesus not suppress one word of truth? And, can you give a few descriptions of Jesus’ intercourse with the people?

Answer: He spoke it always in love. He exercised the greatest tact, and thoughtful, kind attention in His intercourse with the people. And, He was never rude, needlessly spoke a severe word, never gave needless pain to a sensitive soul.

Luke1:68-79 (KJV)

Blessed [be] the Lord God of Israel; for he hath visited and redeemed his people,
And hath raised up an horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David;
As he spake by the mouth of his holy prophets, which have been since the world began:
That we should be saved from our enemies, and from the hand of all that hate us;
To perform the mercy [promised] to our fathers, and to remember his holy covenant;
The oath which he sware to our father Abraham, That he would grant unto us,
that we being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve him without fear,
In holiness and righteousness before him, all the days of our life.
And thou, child, shalt be called the prophet of the Highest:
for thou shalt go before the face of the Lord to prepare his ways;
To give knowledge of salvation unto his people by the remission of their sins,
Through the tender mercy of our God; whereby the dayspring from on high hath visited us,
To give light to them that sit in darkness and [in] the shadow of death,
to guide our feet into the way of peace.

The servants of Christ are not to act out the dictates of the natural heart. They need to have close communion with God, lest, under provocation, self rise up, and they pour forth a torrent of words that are unbecoming, that are not as dew or the still showers that refresh the withering plants.

Question: What are the servants of Christ not to act out? And, what do they need to have?

Answer: They are not to act out the dictates of the natural heart. And, they need to have close communion with God, lest, under provocation, self-rise up, and they pour forth a torrent of words that are unbecoming.

Continuing: This is what Satan wants them to do; for these are his methods. It is the dragon that is wroth; it is the spirit of Satan that is revealed in anger and accusing. But God's servants are to be representatives of Him. He desires them to deal only in the currency of heaven, the truth that bears His own image and superscription. The power by which they are to overcome evil is the power of Christ.

Continuing: The glory of Christ is their strength. They are to fix their eyes upon His loveliness. Then they can present the gospel with divine tact and gentleness. And the spirit that is kept gentle under provocation will speak more effectively in favor of the truth than will any argument, however forcible. {DA 353.2}

Question: What are the methods of Satan and his nature? And, what is the strength of Jesus servants?

Answer: To pour forth a torrent of words that are unbecoming the dragon that is wroth; it is the spirit of Satan that is revealed in anger and accusing. And, the glory of Christ, they are to fix their eyes upon His loveliness.

Those who are brought in controversy with the enemies of truth have to meet, not only men, but Satan and his agents. Let them remember the Saviour's words, "Behold, I send you forth as lambs among wolves." **Luke 10:3.** Let them rest in the love of God, and the spirit will be kept calm, even under personal abuse. The Lord will clothe them with a divine panoply. His Holy Spirit will influence the mind and heart, so that their voices shall not catch the notes of the baying of the wolves. {DA 353.3}

Question: Who else do those who are brought into controversy with the enemies of truth, have to meet? And, what words does the Saviour want them to remember during such times?

Answer: Not only men, but Satan and his agents. And, the Saviour's words, "Behold, I send you forth as lambs among wolves." Let them rest in the love of God, and the spirit will be kept calm, even under personal abuse.

Chapter 3-Peter's Sifting Resulted in His Conversion

And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: but I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren. Luke 22:31, 32. {SD 91.1}

The reason so many of Christ's professed disciples fall into **grievous** temptation is that they have not a correct knowledge of themselves. Here is where Peter was so thoroughly sifted by the enemy. If we could understand our own weakness, we should see so much to do for ourselves that we would humble our hearts under the mighty hand of God. Hanging our helpless souls upon Christ, we would supplement our ignorance with His wisdom, our weakness with His strength, our **frailty** with His enduring might. Peter fell because he did not know his own frailty. He thought himself strong. . . . {SD 91.2}

Had Peter walked humbly with God, hiding self in Christ; had he earnestly looked for divine help; had he been less **self-confident**; had he received the Lord's instruction and practised it, he would have been watching unto prayer. . . . Had he closely examined himself, the Lord would have given him divine help and there would have been no need of Satan's sifting. . . . There is no power in the whole **satanic** force that can disable the soul that trusts, in simple confidence, in the wisdom that comes from God. {SD 91.3}

The **watch-care** of Christ for Peter was the cause of his **restoration**. Satan could do nothing against the **all-powerful intercession** of Christ. And the prayer that Christ offered for Peter He offers in behalf of all who are humble and **contrite** in heart. . . . Peter sinned against light and knowledge, and against great and exalted **privileges**. It was self-confidence that caused him to fail, and it is this same evil that is now working in human hearts. It may be our purpose to be right and to do right, but we shall most surely err unless we are constant learners in the school of Christ. Our only safety is in walking humbly with God. {SD 91.4}

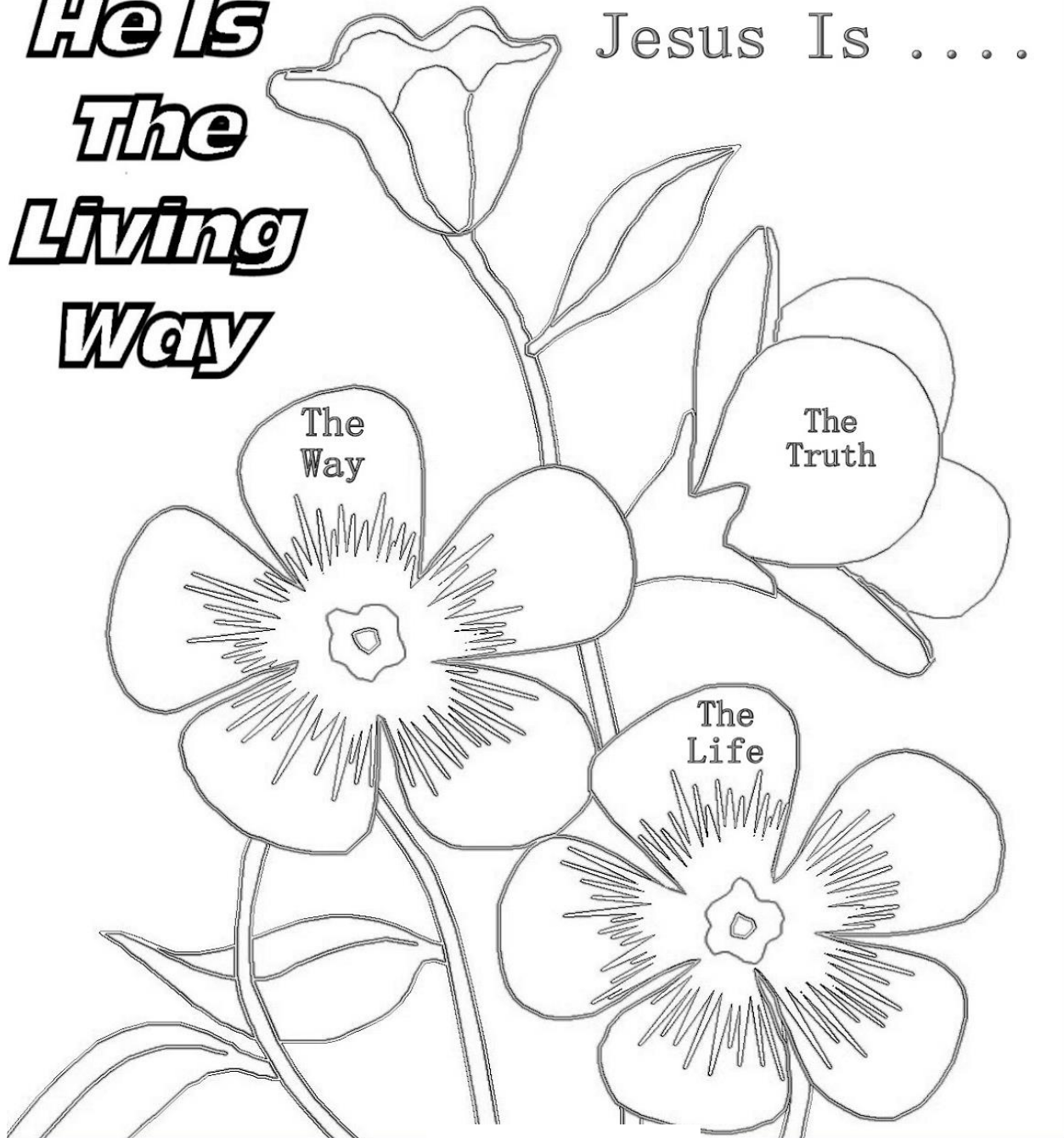

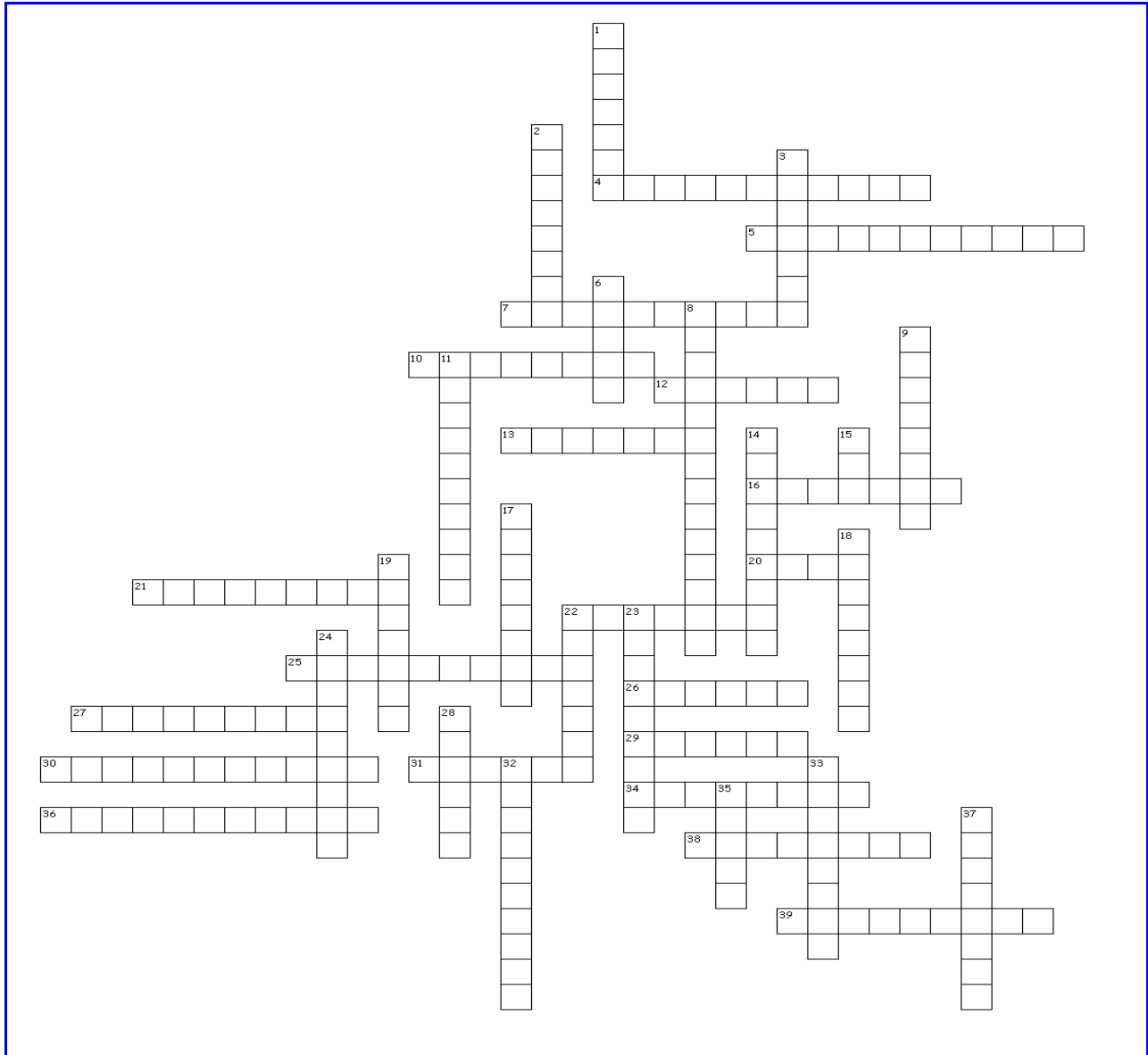
