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Chapter 17 – "The Betrayal and Arrest" Part 2

Jesus said to him, "Friend, wherefore art thou come?" Matthew 26:50. His voice trembled as He added. "Betrayest thou the Son of man with a kiss?" Luke 22:48. {SJ 109.5} These gentle words should have touched the heart of Judas; but all tenderness and honor seemed to have left him. Judas had yielded himself to the control of Satan. He stood boldly before the Lord, and was not ashamed to give Him up to the cruel mob. {SJ 109.6} Christ did not refuse the traitor's kiss. In this He gave us an example of forbearance, love, and pity. If we are His disciples, we must treat our enemies as He treated Judas. **{SJ109.7**} (Next Slide)









Continuing:

The murderous throng became bold as they saw Judas touch the form which had so recently been glorified before their eyes. They now laid hold of the Saviour,

and bound those hands that had ever been employed in doing good. {SJ 109.8}
The disciples did not think that Christ would allow Himself to be taken.
They knew that the power which could strike down the mob as dead men could keep them helpless till Christ and His companions should escape. {SJ 109.9}
They were disappointed and indignant as they saw the cords brought forward to bind the hands of Him whom they loved.

Peter, in his anger, rashly drew his sword, and tried to defend his Master. But he only cut off an ear of the high priest's servant. **{SJ 110.1}**

Nature What is Man?

We have learned what a mammal is and now let us learn *"What is Man?"*

"And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

"So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them" (Genesis 1:26-27). Man's body was formed in the same way that the bodies of the animals were formed, of the dust of the earth. (Genesis 1:24; 2:7). Man would have the "breath of life," like the animals (Genesis 2:7; 7:22), but man would be different. He was made in the image of God, "a new and distinct order," possessing a mind with which he could choose to serve God or not to serve Him. Consider these thoughts:

"After the earth was created, and the beasts upon it, the Father and Son carried out their purpose, which was designed before the fall of Satan, to make man in their own image. "They had wrought together in the creation of the earth and every living thing upon it. And now God says to His Son, *'Let us make man in our image.'* As Adam came forth from the hand of his Creator, he was of noble height, and of beautiful symmetry. He was more than twice as tall as men now living upon the earth, and was well proportioned. His features were

perfect and beautiful. His complexion was neither white, nor sallow, but ruddy, glowing with the rich tint of health. Eve was not quite as tall as Adam. Her head reached a little above his shoulders. She, too, was noble—perfect in symmetry, and very beautiful." (3 Spiritual Gifts 34)

"After the earth with its teeming animal and vegetable life had been called into existence, man, the crowning work of the Creator, and the one for whom the beautiful earth had been fitted up, was brought upon the stage of action. To him was given dominion over all that his eye could behold; for 'God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over...all the earth.... So God created man in His own image... male and female created he them.' Here is clearly set forth the origin of the human race; and the divine record is so plainly stated that there is no occasion for erroneous conclusions. God created man in His own image. Here is no mystery. There is no ground for the supposition that man was evolved by slow degrees of development from the lower forms of animal or vegetable life. Such teaching lowers the great work of the Creator to the level of man's narrow, earthly conceptions. Men

are so intent upon excluding God from the sovereignty of the universe that they degrade man and defraud him of the dignity of his origin. He who set the starry worlds on high and tinted with delicate skill the flowers of the field, who filled the earth and the heavens with the wonders of His power, when He came to crown His glorious work, to place one in the midst to stand as ruler of the fair earth, did not fail to create a being worthy of the hand that gave him life. The genealogy of our race, as given by inspiration, traces back its origin, not to a line of developing germs,

mollusks, and quadrupeds, but to the great Creator. Though formed from the dust, Adam was *'the son of God.'*



"He was placed, as God's representative, over the lower orders of being. They cannot understand or acknowledge the sovereignty of God, yet they were made capable of loving and serving man. The psalmist says, *'Thou madest him to have dominion over the works of Thy hands; Thou hast put all things under his feet... the beasts of the field; the fowl of the air... and whatsoever passeth through the paths of the seas'* (Psalm 8:6-8).

"Man was to bear God's image, both in outward resemblance and in character. Christ alone is *'the express image'* (Hebrews 1:3) of the Father; but man was formed in the likeness of God. His nature was in harmony with the will of God. His mind was capable of comprehending divine things. His affections were pure; his appetites and passions were under the control of reason. He was holy and happy in bearing the image of God and in perfect obedience to His will." (*Patriarchs and Prophets* 44-45) When he chose to sin, man fell! God now is trying to bring man back to bear His image in character. To change our characters we must behold Jesus with the eye of faith as the Samaritan people did. "But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory [character] of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the spirit of the Lord" (II Corinthians 3:18).

Continuing: Satan saw that his disguise was torn away. His administration was laid open before the unfallen angels and before the heavenly universe. He had revealed himself as a murderer. By shedding the blood of the Son of God, he had uprooted himself from the sympathies of the heavenly beings. **Henceforth his** work was restricted. **{Next Slide Please}**



Continuing: Whatever attitude he might assume, he could no longer await the angels as they came from the heavenly courts, and before them accuse **Christ's brethren of** being clothed with the garments of blackness and the defilement of sin. The last link of sympathy between Satan and the heavenly world was broken. **{DA 761.2}**



Yet Satan was not then destroyed. The angels did not even then understand all that was involved in the great controversy. The principles at stake were to be more fully revealed. And for the sake of man, Satan's existence must be continued. Man as well as angels must see the contrast between the Prince of light and the prince of darkness. He must choose whom he will serve. **{DA 761.3**}



In the opening of the great controversy, Satan had declared that the law of God could not be obeyed, that justice was inconsistent with mercy, and that, should the law be broken, it would be impossible for the sinner to be pardoned. **Every sin must meet its** punishment, urged Satan; and if God should remit the punishment of sin, He would not be a God of truth and justice. **{Next Slide Please}**







When men broke the law of God, and defied His will, Satan exulted. It was proved, he declared, that the law could not be obeyed; man could not be forgiven. **Because he, after his rebellion,** had been banished from heaven, Satan claimed that the human race must be forever shut out from God's favor. God could not be just, he urged, and yet show mercy to the sinner. **{DA 761.4}**

The law of the LORD [is] perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD [is] sure, making wise the simple. More to be desired [are they] than gold, yea, than much fine gold: sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb. (Chorus 4 x) (2 x) The statutes of the LORD [are] right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the LORD [is] pure, enlightening the eyes.

The fear of the LORD [is] clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD [are] true [and] righteous altogether.

(chorus) Moreover by them is thy servant warned: (2 x) [and] in keeping of them [there is] great reward. (2 x) (chorus) Who can understand [his] errors? cleanse thou me from secret [faults]. Keep back thy servant also from presumptuous [sins]; let them not have dominion over me: then shall I be upright, and I shall be innocent from the great transgression.

Continuing: But even as a sinner, man was in a different position from that of Satan. Lucifer in heaven had sinned in the light of God's glory. To him as to no other created being was given a revelation of God's love. Understanding the character of God, knowing His goodness, Satan chose to follow his own selfish, independent will. **{Next Slide Please}**



Continuing: This choice was final. There was no more that God could do to save him. But man was deceived; his mind was darkened by Satan's sophistry. The height and depth of the love of God he did not know. For him there was hope in a knowledge of God's love. **By beholding His character** he might be drawn back to God. **{DA 761.5}**







Through Jesus, God's mercy was manifested to men; but mercy does not set aside justice. The law reveals the attributes of God's character, and not a jot or tittle of it could be changed to meet man in his fallen condition. God did not change His law, but He sacrificed Himself, in Christ, for man's redemption. "God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto Himself." 2 Corinthians 5:19 **{DA 762.1}**

Continuing: More than this, Christ imbues men with the attributes of God. He builds up the human character after the similitude of the divine character, a goodly fabric of spiritual strength and beauty. Thus the very righteousness of the law is fulfilled in the believer in Christ. God can "be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus." **Romans 3:26. {DA 762.2}**
