Chapter 17 – "The Betrayal and Arrest" Part 3

Continuing: When Jesus saw what was done, He released His hands, though held firmly by the Roman soldiers, and saying, "Suffer ye thus far" (Luke 22:51), He touched the wounded ear, and it was instantly made whole. {SJ 110.2} He then said to Peter, "Put up again thy sword into his place: for all they that take the sword shall perish with the sword. Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to My Father, and He shall presently give Me more than twelve legions of angels? But how then shall the Scriptures be fulfilled, that thus it must be?" Matthew 26:52-54. "The cup which My Father hath given Me, shall I not drink it?" John 18:11. {SJ 110.3} Christ then turned to the chief priests and the captains of the temple, who were with the mob, and said, "Are ye come out as against a thief, with swords and with staves to take me? (Next Slide)



Continuing: I was daily with you in the temple teaching, and ye took Me not: but the Scriptures must be fulfilled." Mark 14:48, 49. {SJ 110.4} The disciples were offended when they saw that the Saviour made no effort to deliver Himself from His enemies. They blamed Him for not doing so. They could not understand His submission to the mob, and, terror-stricken, they forsook Him and fled. {SJ 110.5} Christ had foretold this desertion. "Behold," He had said, "the hour cometh, yea, is now come, that ye shall be scattered, every man to his own, and shall leave Me alone: and yet I am not alone, because the Father is with Me." John 16:32. {SJ 110.6}

Reverence vs Disrespectfulness Reverence is respect and affection for God and spiritual things.

Bodies of Mammals

Each mammal is uniquely different. Some are very large, like the blue whale. From the tip of its tail to its head it is as tall as a ten-story building. Then there is the tiny shrew which is about the length of your little finger. There are mammals of all sizes, shapes, and colors in between.

Each one has a body created for its way of life. Just so, God gives *"to every man his work."* "Each has his place in the eternal plan of heaven." (*Christ's Object Lessons* 326) A couple of examples of the ways that mammals' bodies are adapted to the purposes of their lives are: 1. Deer and other mammals like them have thin bodies with legs set close to the sides. God made their lower leg and foot bones long and slender so they could travel at high speeds. This helps to deliver them from evil.

2. The elephant can carry great weight because of its short, heavy legs. Prayer helps support the Christian during heavy trials.

Remind

1. As you work together as a family, let your chores remind you of your lesson.

2. Before you do your chores, pray for God's help in assisting you with each task. After you have completed a difficult chore, thank God for helping you while doing chores. Notice how your body is adapted (especially made) for service. For instance, try doing a chore without using your thumbs.

3. Live and act in such a way that you bring honor to the family name you bear, remembering that whatever you do will cast a reflection on your father's reputation. Let it remind you that you are also a member of God's family, and bear His name. Protect God's reputation by living like a son or daughter of His. *"Thou, O Lord, art in the midst of us, and we are called by Thy name"* (Jeremiah 14:9).

Continuing: God's love has been expressed in His justice no less than in His mercy. Justice is the foundation of His throne, and the fruit of His love. It had been Satan's purpose to divorce mercy from truth and justice. He sought to prove that the righteousness of God's law is an enemy to peace. **But Christ shows that in God's** plan they are indissolubly joined together; the one cannot exist without the other. **{Next Slide Please}**

Continuing: "Mercy and truth are met together; righteousness and peace have kissed each other." Psalm 85:10. {DA 762.3}

By His life and His death, **Christ proved that God's** justice did not destroy His mercy, but that sin could be forgiven, and that the law is righteous, and can be perfectly obeyed. Satan's charges were refuted. God had given man unmistakable evidence of His love. {DA 762.4}

Another deception was now to be brought forward. Satan declared that mercy destroyed justice, that the death of Christ abrogated the Father's law. Had it been possible for the law to be changed or abrogated, then Christ need not have died. But to abrogate the law would be to immortalize transgression, and place the world under Satan's control. **{Next Slide Please}**



"The justice, the moral excellence, of the law must be maintained and vindicated before the heavenly universe. And that holy law could not be maintained at any smaller price than the death of the Son of God." {RH, The Review and Heral November 15, 1898 par. 3}

Continuing: It was because the law was changeless, because man could be saved only through obedience to its precepts, that Jesus was lifted up on the cross. Yet the very means by which Christ established the law Satan represented as destroying it. Here will come the last conflict of the great controversy between Christ and Satan. **{DA 762.5}**

That the law which was spoken by God's own voice is faulty, that some specification has been set aside, is the claim which Satan now puts forward. It is the last great deception that he will bring upon the world. He needs not to assail the whole law; if he can lead men to disregard one precept, his purpose is gained. For "whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all." James 2:10. **{Next Slide Please}**

"Satan has been persevering and untiring in his efforts to prosecute the work he began in heaven, to change the law of God. He has succeeded in making the world believe the theory he presented in heaven before his fall, that the law of God was faulty, and needed revising. Margin... {2SM 107.2}
