



Chapter 22 – "Condemned by Pilate" Part 6

Continuing: So all who compromise with sin will gain only sorrow and ruin. "There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death." Proverbs 14:12. {SJ 138.1} When Pilate declared himself innocent of the blood of Christ, Caiaphas answered defiantly, "His blood be on us, and on our children." Matthew 27:25. {SJ 138.2} And the awful words were echoed by the priests, and re-echoed by the people. **{SJ 138.3**} It was a terrible sentence to pass upon themselves. It was an awful heritage to hand down to their posterity. **{SJ 138.4**} Literally was this fulfilled upon themselves in the fearful scenes of the destruction of Jerusalem, about forty years later. {SJ 138.5} (Next Slide)



Continuing: Literally has it been fulfilled in the scattered, despised, and oppressed condition of their descendants since that day. {SJ 138.6} Doubly literal will be the fulfillment when the final accounting shall come. The scene will then be changed, and "this same Jesus" will come, "in flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God." Acts 1:11; 2 Thessalonians 1:8. {SJ 138.7} Then they will pray to the rocks and mountains: {SJ 138.8} "Fall on us, and hide us from the face of Him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb: for the great day of His wrath is come." Revelation 6:16, 17. {SJ 138.9}





A Camel's Head


Remember, a camel is a mammal. The body of the camel is designed to live where few other animals can live. This reminds me how few people have faith like the centurion. The camel has large eyes on the sides of its head with bushy eyebrows. Each eye is protected by a double row of long lashes that catch most of the sand that would blow from off the desert. If some sand gets into an eye, a camel has a special third eyelid to get it out. It moves like a windshield wiper on a car, from side to side. This eyelid is so thin a camel can see through it. During a sandstorm a camel often closes the extra evelids and keeps walking. Special glands supply the eyes of a camel with much water to keep the eyes moist. Its head has a built-in sun visor to help keep the bright sunlight out of its eyes. There are wide ridges of bone above each eye. These stick out enough to make shade for the eye when the sun is overhead.

The camel has small, rounded ears far back on its head. These little ears are covered with hair outside and inside which help keep out blowing sand or dust of the desert. A camel has good hearing, but often pays no attention to commands. You can see why it is not **trustworthy**. God wants us to be sensitive to the commands of the Holy Spirit and our parents.

A Camel's Head



In the mouth of the camel are 34 strong, sharp teeth. It uses these teeth as weapons. Some camel owners cover the mouth with a muzzle to keep it from biting. Camels can have bad tempers. And once they do not like a person, they may dislike that person for years. An angry camel can be mean. A smart camel owner uses a method to help calm their camels. They give the camels their own coat off of their backs, then the camel will rip it to shreds. After the camel is finished it seems a lot calmer. Do you know some people that act this way? What kind of temper do you have?

The nose of a camel can close up tight to keep blowing sand out of it. When there is no sand blowing, the camel opens its nostrils to breathe through its nose.

> Jesus made the camel's nose So it would shut so tight. When desert sands are blowing, They shut it just right.

Each part of the camel's head is designed to help the camel work and live on or near the desert.

Continuing: Late as it is, they know that the disciples will not sleep till they learn for a certainty what has become of the body of their Lord. They find the door of the chamber securely barred. They knock for admission, but no answer comes. All is still. Then they give their names. The door is carefully unbarred, they enter, and Another, unseen, enters with them. Then the door is again fastened, to keep out spies. **{DA 802.1}**


