







Chapter 25 – "In Joseph's Tomb" Part 2

All Manner of Mammals

In the Bible are listed many kinds of mammals. Some of these are the coney, the hare, the mouse, the hedgehog, the porcupine, the mole-rat, the bat, and the whale.

"And God created great whales..." (Genesis 1:21). A whale is a huge sea animal that looks a lot like a fish. Whales were sometimes called fish but they are not fish. They belong to the group of animals called mammals. Probably because they live in the water and are shaped somewhat like a fish they are thought of as fish. Part of our Bible story takes place this week on the water which can remind us of where the whales live.

A mammal has these characteristics:

- 1. Warm-blooded,
- 2. Has a backbone,



- 3. Two pairs of limbs,
- 4. More or less complete covering of hair
- 5. Feeds its babies with milk,
- Most give their young protection and training, and
- Mammals have a larger, more welldeveloped brain than other animals.



Two Groups of Whales

The Baleen Whales and Toothed Whales

Most whales are very large creatures. One kind, called the blue whale, may grow to be 100 feet (30 meters) long and can weigh more than 220 short tons (220 metric tons). This means they would be about as long as four long buses put end to end, and its weight equal to thirty elephants. The blue whale's tongue alone is as heavy as one elephant. However, other kinds of whales are much smaller.

The whale is shaped like a fish, but is different from a fish in many ways. For example, fish have up and down (vertical) tail fins but whales have side-to-side (horizontal) tail fins. Fish breathe with gills while whales have lungs and must come to the surface of the water to breathe. But they can hold their breath for a very long time. The sperm whale can hold its breath for 75 minutes. Whales have blow holes that serve as a sort of "nose" on top of their heads. There are two groups of whales, baleen whales and toothed whales. Baleen whales do not have teeth, while the toothed whales do.



Whales belong to a group of mammals called ceteceans (See TAY shuhnz) which means "large sea animals."



Sperm Whale

Whales give birth to live young and feed them with milk made by the mother's body. Most fish lay eggs and do not nurse their offspring. Whales are warm-blooded, which means their body temperature stays the same no matter what the temperature is around them. Almost all fish are cold-blooded, which means their body temperature changes with the temperature of the water.

So you can see, a whale is not a fish, it is a mammal.


There is a difference between a person that obeys God and has perfect peace and one who is <u>willful</u> and does not obey Jesus had perfect peace!


The enormous bodies of whales were used as a great source of riches for men. They melted their fat for oil, the meat was eaten, and people found there were many other uses for the whale's body. During the 1900's, whaling fleets killed large numbers of whales. Then laws were made to limit the amount of whales that could be killed each year; otherwise it was feared that whale hunters would have destroyed some kinds of whales, then they would have perished from off the face of the earth. This can remind us how the disciples thought they were going to perish in the terrible storm on the sea. Just as some people made plans to save the whales, likewise Jesus had plans to save the disciples from the angry storm and their sins. Sperm

The Evils
of Whaling

In a harrowing incident of whaling, on a Pacific voyage, boats from the Yankee whaling ship Anne Alexander attacked a large sperm whale that breached (leapt out of the water) among the boats, lost its balance and fell over on its back, crushing one of the boats. It then rammed and sank the Anne Alexander itself. The crew survived two weeks in an open boat before being rescued by the whaling ship Nan-≤tucket.
















The commission had been given to the twelve when Christ met with them in the upper chamber; but it was now to be given to a larger number. At the meeting on a mountain in Galilee, all the believers who could be called together were assembled. them in Galilee.


The promise was repeated to the believers who were gathered at Jerusalem during the Passover week, and through them it reached many lonely ones who were mourning the death of their Lord.

to the interview.





Continuing: They made their way to the place of meeting by circuitous routes, coming in from every direction, to avoid exciting the suspicion of the jealous Jews. With wondering hearts they came, talking earnestly together of the news that had reached them concerning Christ. **{DA 818.2}**








At the time appointed, about five hundred believers were collected in little knots on the mountainside, eager to learn all that could be learned from those who had seen Christ since His resurrection.

From group to group

From group to group the disciples passed, telling all they had seen and heard of Jesus, and reasoning from the Scriptures as He had done with them.


Thomas recounted the story of his unbelief, {Next Slide Please}



Continuing: and told how his doubts had been swept away. **Suddenly Jesus stood** among them. No one could tell whence or how He came. Many who were present had never before seen Him; but in His hands and feet they beheld the marks of the crucifixion; His countenance was as the face of God, and when they saw Him, they worshiped Him. **{DA 818.3}**



But some doubted. So it will always be. There are those who find it hard to exercise faith, and they place themselves on the doubting side. These lose much because of their unbelief. **{DA 819.1}**




This was the only interview that Jesus had with many of the believers after His resurrection. He came and spoke to them saying, "All power is given unto Me in heaven and in earth." The disciples had worshiped Him before He spoke, but His words, falling from lips that had been closed in death, thrilled them with peculiar power. He was now the risen Saviour. Many of them had seen Him exercise His power in healing the sick and controlling satanic agencies. {Next Slide please}



Continuing:

They believed that He possessed power to set up His kingdom at Jerusalem, power to quell all opposition, power over the elements of nature. He had stilled the angry waters; He had walked upon the white-crested billows; He had raised the dead to life. Now He declared that "all power" was given to Him. His words carried the minds of His hearers above earthly and temporal things to the heavenly and eternal. They were lifted to the highest conception of His dignity

and glory. {DA 819.2}
