
Character Quality

Obedience vs Willfulness
Obedience is compliance with God's
commands done quickly and cheerfully.



Whales are very powerful animals but they are also very gentle in their disposition. They remind us of Christ's character. He exercised the great power of God in stilling the storm and at the same time He acted gently toward his fearful disciples. "They read in His glance self-forgetful, tender love." (*The Desire of Ages* 335)

The whale was especially designed by the Creator to live in the water. It has some special body features that help it to survive in water.



The shape of a whale is such that helps it to swim freely through the water. Its powerful tail fins (flukes) are positioned on the sides of its tail. The whale can move itself through the water by moving its tail up and down. When moving fast a whale beats its tail up and down about two times in a second. One kind of whale, called a right whale, has been seen to use its tail for a sail. The whales raised their flukes from the water and set them against a strong on-shore wind. Their "sail-tails" would catch the wind and provide them a ride to shallow waters. Then they would turn around, swim back to the deep-water, and set sail again. They would sometimes spend an entire afternoon in this kind of activity which evidently is splendid fun for them.


The flippers also help in steering and keeping it in balance. The flippers are like arms for the whale. Mother whales are often seen swimming side by side with their young ones with their flippers touching-they are "holding hands!" The way they stay close together helps to protect the little one. It can remind us how the disciples did not need to be afraid with Jesus close by them.

Some toothed whales have strong muscles that give such power they can leap high out of the water and into the air. A killer whale (12,000 pounds [5,400 kilograms]) has been known to jump 20 feet (6 meters) into the air. Why do they jump? To give an alarm, or show their strength, or attract females. The young seem to jump in play! The jump of a large whale makes a very noisy splash. Gray whales often "spy hop," which means they thrust their heads high out of the water so they can look around and see their location.





The whale needs strength to swim through stormy seas. This tells us about: "Those hardy fishermen who had spent their lives upon the lake, and guided their craft safely through many a storm; but now their strength and skill availed nothing. They were helpless in the grasp of the tempest, and hope failed them as they saw that their boat was filling." They needed the help of Jesus to be saved! "Lord, save us: we perish." "And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm." The waves obeyed their Master!




A whale's backbone, shoulder blades, and rib cage are similar to those of other mammals.

The whale has seven neck vertebrae, as do all mammals. These vertebrae are squeezed into short lengths or joined into one bone. This helps the head from moving about as a whale swims. It also joins the head and body together so it can move through the water with greater ease. When the church body (Christ's disciples) is joined to the head (Jesus) the church can work with greater ease. "But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ" (Ephesians 4:15).

Narwhal

The narwhal is a small to mediumsized whale that resembles the beluga. Besides its spotted pigmentation, however, it has one radically distinguishing characteristic: its tusk. Borne only by the male, this ivory "horn," actually a twisted, overgrown tooth, may reach 9 feet in length. It is not known its use. Tragically, the uniqueness of the tusk has caused the narwhal to be overhunted, and this unusual creature is now endangered.



Remind

- 1. As you work together as a family, let your chores remind you of your lesson.
- 2. As you shut windows before or during a big storm, remember "peace, be still."
- 3. God made man to use his hands and feet to move and do physical work each day as a whale uses its fins to move through the water. When we do our chores, we are **obeying** God's command to get exercise each day.
- 4. When you go shopping, stay close to your mother for safety, remembering how little whales swim next to their mothers. And remember to ask for Jesus' protection, too.
- 5. When you feel "stormy" in your mind, pray for Jesus' help to calm you down.

- 1. Look for mammals! Use your guide book to identify them.
- 2. Find pictures of whales to put on your bulletin board.
- 3. Read the story of Jonah and the whale from the book of Jonah.
- 4. Sing the hymn, "Peace, Be Still!"


Continuing: Clothed with boundless authority, He gave His commission to the disciples: "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations," "baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost: **Teaching them to observe** all things whatsoever I commanded you: and lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world." Matthew 28:19, 20. **{DA 819.3}**







The Jewish people had been made the depositaries of sacred truth; but Pharisaism had made them the most exclusive, the most bigoted, of all the human race. **Everything about the priests** and rulers--their dress, customs, ceremonies, traditions made them unfit to be the light of the world. **{Next Slide Please}**



Continuing: They looked upon themselves, the Jewish nation, as the world. **But Christ commissioned** His disciples to proclaim a faith and worship that would have in it nothing of caste or country, a faith that would be adapted to all peoples, all nations, all classes of men. **{DA 819.4}**




Before leaving His disciples, Christ plainly stated the nature of His kingdom.

Continuing:


All had been foretold by men inspired by the Holy Spirit. He said, You see that all I have revealed to you concerning My rejection as the Messiah has come to pass.

All I have said in regard to the humiliation I should endure and the death I should die, has been verified. On the third day I rose again. Search the


Scriptures more diligently, and you will see that in all these things the specifications of prophecy concerning Me have been fulfilled. {DA 820.1}









Christ commissioned His disciples to do the work He had left in their hands, beginning at Jerusalem. Jerusalem had been the scene of His amazing condescension for the human race. There He had suffered, been rejected and condemned. The land of Judea was His birthplace. There, clad in the garb of humanity, He had walked with men, and few had discerned how near heaven came to the earth when Jesus was among them. At Jerusalem the work of the disciples must begin. **{DA 820.2}**



In view of all that Christ had suffered there, and the unappreciated labor He had put forth, the disciples might have pleaded for a more promising field; but they made no such plea. The very ground where He had scattered the seed of truth was to be cultivated by the disciples, and the seed would spring up and yield an abundant harvest. {Next Slide please}



Continuing: In their work the disciples would have to meet persecution through the jealousy and hatred of the Jews; but this had been endured by their Master, and they were not to flee from it. The first offers of mercy must be made to the murderers of the Saviour. **{DA 820.3}**



And there were in Jerusalem many who had secretly believed on Jesus, and many who had been deceived by the priests and rulers.


To these also the gospel was to be presented.


They were to be called
