

Chapter 25 – "In Joseph's Tomb" Part 4


### **Character Quality**

**Obedience vs Willfulness Obedience** is compliance with God's commands done quickly and cheerfully.



#### Whales—Skin and Blubber

Whales have smooth, thin skin, and are not scaly like fish. Their skin feels rubbery to the touch. Their smooth skin also helps them slip easily through the water. Most mammals are covered with hair which protects them by holding warm air next to the body. Whales do not have a coat of hair to keep them warm, instead, underneath the skin, is an enormous layer of thick fat called blubber. It may be as much as twenty inches (50.8 centimeters) thick. However, whales do have a few hairs on their heads. If food is not available, like a camel that can go without food for a long time, so whales can live off their blubber for a long time. Blubber is lighter than water so it helps the whales float on the water. Blubber is so soft that it is almost like a liquid. The skin and blubber and the underlying areas of connective tissue act like fluids in motion. This soft, fluid-like covering of the whale spreads out the pressure of the water evenly when the whales dive down deep. It is like a special diving suit that acts like a life preserver. Obedience is the Christian's life preserver. It helps us to go deeper into spiritual experience.



The great whales are usually only bothered in the sea by very small animals such as parasites and other tiny animals that attach themselves to the whale's skin and suck its blood. Sometimes tiny shellfish called barnacles find a place to live on a whale's body. There they go along for the ride as they strain their food from the water passing by. They can form big colonies on the body of the whale. One humpback whale was found that had a half ton (about 5 metric ton) of barnacles on it. Barnacles are most likely to get a foothold on the slower moving kinds of whales, such as the humpbacks. What can be learned from this? Barnacles are like the "little sins" that can add up in a person's life who is not being obedient.

They make a person "heavy laden." Jesus says, "Come unto me all ye that...are heavy laden and I will give you rest" (Matthew 11:28). The rest He promises is rest from sin. Did you know that the overcoming of little evils, little sins, little indulgences of the flesh, make up our greatest victories? It is only when "in despair of self-dependence" that we turn to Jesus that we get the power to overcome them, (The Desire of Ages 336) and like the barnacles attach more easily to a slow-moving whale, so does sin find a foothold in that Christian that is "slow-of heart to believe" (Luke 24:25).

As we study about the whale we can truly say, "What manner of mammal is this!?" So the disciples said of Jesus, "What manner of man is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?"


## Remind

1. As you work together as a family, let your chores remind you of your lesson.

2. As you make popcorn and pour a <u>little</u> cold-pressed olive oil over it, be reminded of the huge amount of blubber a whale has in its body.

3. As you run the blender and watch it churn up the food, remember the churning storm on the sea. When you shut off the blender be reminded of the words, *"peace, be still."*  4. When you put your coat or sweater on to go outside, remember the coat of blubber the whales have to protect them from the cold water. **Obedience** protects us from the freezing cold blasts of sin. When you help pack food for father's lunch and fill the thermos bottle, let it remind you that a whale has been called a "great thermos bottle" because of its insulating layer of blubber.

5. When you are tempted to do a "little sin," consider the slow whales and the barnacles.

At that time poisoning was often practiced. **Unscrupulous men did** not hesitate to remove by this means those who stood in the way of their ambition. Jesus knew that the life of His disciples would thus be imperiled. Many would think it doing God service to put His witnesses to death. He therefore promised them protection from this danger. **{DA 821.3}** 



The disciples were to have the same power which Jesus had to heal "all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people." By healing in His name the diseases of the body, they would testify to His power for the healing of the soul. Matthew 4:23; 9:6. And a new endowment was now promised. **{Next Slide Please}** 




**Continuing:** The disciples were to preach among other nations, and they would receive power to speak other tongues. The apostles and their associates were unlettered men, yet through the outpouring of the Spirit on the day of Pentecost, their speech, whether in their own or a foreign language, became pure, simple, and accurate, both in word and in accent. **{DA 821.4}** 





All to whom the heavenly inspiration has come are put in trust with the gospel. **{Next Slide Please}**
