Chapter 26 – "He is Risen"

## Nature

#### Whales—Breathing Senses and Disposition

Like all mammals, whales have lungs that enable them to breathe. They must come to the surface to breathe every 5 to 75 minutes depending on the kind (or species) of whale. The whale's lungs are located in just the right place inside the whale to give it perfect balance. Whales can go a long time without breathing for these reasons. They store more oxygen in their muscles than most mammals. When diving, a whale's body decreases blood flow to its body but not to the heart and brain. The heartbeat slows and this saves oxygen. After diving, a whale must take several breaths to fill the tissues with oxygen before going under again.

When a whale comes up to breathe, it rolls forward as it comes up out of the water. This movement gives the whale two seconds to blow out and breathe in air (2,100 quarts of air! [2,000 liters]). It breathes through its "nose," called a blowhole on top of its head. Toothed whales have one blowhole, but baleen whales have two. Strong muscles and valves open the blowhole wide for whales to breathe, then it shuts tight. This can remind us that prayer is the breath of the soul. So as the whale needs oxygen to live and have power to swim, the Christian needs prayer with His Father so that when the waves and the wild men tried to rush upon Him He had the power to stop them. When breathing out (exhaling) a whale causes a cloud, called a blow or spout. This is made up of mostly water vapor

with some mucus and oil droplets. It is sort of like a cloud of mist that forms when moist air hits cooler air. The blow is about 6 feet high (1.8 meters) in humpback whales and up to 25 feet high (8 meters) in sperm whales. As the water sprays up from the whale's blowhole, so our prayers ascend like sweet incense into the heavenly courts.

The shape and size of a spout can help a person watching to tell what kind of whale it is. For example, one species of whale called the right whale has a heart-shaped spout. Its spout reminds us, *"Let everything that hath breath praise the Lord"* (Psalm 150:6). Whales are naturally shy and timid creatures. They avoid fights and danger when they can, and with surprising swiftness they swim away from their enemies. This can remind us how the disciples' first reaction was to flee from the demoniacs.

Whales do not smell, see, or taste well. However, their sense of touch and hearing is very good. Their hearing helps them with information about their surroundings. They hear sounds that are too low and high for humans to hear. People cannot hear well underwater but whales cannot only hear, but also can tell where the sound is coming from.

Toothed whales make sounds in air-filled pouches around the blowhole. The whales find things underwater by listening for the echoes made when objects reflect the sounds. From the echoes, they can tell how far to an object and the direction is which it lies. Whales make a wide range of noises such as moans, thumps, chirps, whistles, and clicks to communicate. The low-frequency sound of a baleen whale can be heard 1,000 miles 91,600 km.) away. The blue whale makes a very loud whistling sound which is thought to be the loudest sound made by a living creature. Humpback whales are known for their songs. The songs are made up of several sounds and last up to half an hour. It has a pattern with a beginning and an end. If interrupted while singing it will begin again exactly where it left off. The madmen made "<u>sounds</u>" in their souls asking to be delivered from sin. This was like music to God! Jesus heard them and delivered them from Satan.

Distress calls from an injured whale can attract other whales from miles away. Jesus is drawn to lost souls whom Satan has injured, such as the demoniacs.

Groups of Humpback whales in an area sing the same songs from year to year which only slightly change. Each whale in the group has its special way of singing the songs.

Killer whales talk a lot. They live in groups called <u>pods</u>, and each <u>pod</u> has its own special calls. If they are separated they find each other again by these familiar calls. It can remind us how, when we have become separated from Christ through <u>disobedience</u>, we can find His presence again through calling on Him in prayer. He will pity us like He did the demoniacs. *"Then they cried unto the Lord in their trouble, and He delivered them out of their distresses"* (Psalm 107:6).

"They shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover." This world is a vast lazar house, but Christ came to heal the sick, to proclaim deliverance to the captives of Satan. He was in Himself health and strength. He imparted His life to the sick, the afflicted, those possessed of demons. He turned away none who came to receive His healing power. **{Next Slide Please}** 



He knew that those who petitioned Him for help had brought disease upon themselves; yet He did not refuse to heal them. And when virtue from Christ entered into these poor souls, they were convicted of sin, and many were healed of their spiritual disease, as well as of their physical maladies. The gospel still possesses the same power, and why should we not today witness the same results? **{DA 823.3**}
