Nature

The Life of a Whale

Whales have close knit families. They are affectionate and stroke their family members with their sensitive flippers. The humpback whales especially show a lot of affection to their mates. They have very long flippers which sometimes grow to 14 feet (about 4 meters). They use them to hug each other! The couple likes to splash and roll together in the sea. They are very choosy in picking out their mates. They make sure it is one they can get along with all right before they settle down to the business of raising a family. The male whale is called a bull, the female, a cow,


and the baby, a calf. Most female cows carry their babies inside their bodies from 10 to 12 months, depending on the kind of whale. One calf is born at a time. It is very rare for twins to be born. Baby whales are born under the water. Since whales are mammals each calf is attached to its mother by an umbilical cord. The mother snaps the umbilical cord and then it withers away on the calf and leaves behind a "belly button" or navel. One or more females usually help the cow during birth. A newborn whale may weigh 2 short tons (1.8 metric tons) and be 23 feet (7 meters)



in length. As soon as it is born the mother and other female helper whales move it to the surface to take its first breath. The air makes the blow hole open, and baby takes its first breath. The babies can swim immediately after birth. The newborn whale reminds us of newborn Christians, like the two demoniacs. Now they would obey Jesus instead of Satan.

The mother whale takes good care of her baby who stays close to her for at least a year. Often the calf swims just below its mother's flipper. It can remind us of the text. "under his wings shalt thou trust" (Psalm 91:4). It can also remind us how the demoniacs "desired the company of their Deliverer." (The Desire of Ages 339)

The mother carefully looks after her baby and defends it if there is any sign of danger, even if it means her own death. A mother whale will even lay a protective flipper over her baby. Unlike the mother whale, Jesus had to leave the two men He had healed. We are told. "In terror the people thronged about Jesus, beseeching Him to depart from them, and He complied, taking ship at once for the opposite shore."



A newborn blue whale is about twenty three feet long. It weighs about 16,000 pounds (7,200 kilograms).


It is larger than an African elephant.

Some whales' milk contains 10 times more fat and protein than human or cow's milk.


Calves can drink 160 gallons (608 liters) of milk a day which will double their weight in a week.

The mother whale feeds her baby milk. Soon after the baby whale is born and has its first breath mother turns on her side so the calf can reach her teats. They come out of special slits on the underside of her body near the tail. Feeding is done quickly between breaths. Most baby animals suck their milk, but mother whale has special muscles around the teats which pump the milk into her baby's mouth. It feeds little at a time but often. As baby feeds, so the two men desired the words (milk) of life from Jesus. "As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby" (I Peter 2:2). Mother's milk has much fat, protein, and minerals so baby whale grows very fast. A baby blue whale gains 200 pounds (91 kilograms) per day and some baby whales double their weight in a week. Some mothers nurse their babies for almost a year. A sperm whale nurses its baby for up to two years.

After a few months the baby whale starts to move farther from its mother. If it goes too far away she will chase it and may even spank it with her tail. In this way the calf learns to be obedient. Unlike the baby whale, the two men did not want to leave Jesus. "...They kept close to His side, knelt at His feet, and begged Him to keep them near Him, where they might ever listen to His words."



Gray whale mothers often blow bubbles beneath their calves in a blow-and-bounce-the-baby behavior. Or she may slide under her calf, rolling and bouncing the infant in the sea water, or take it for a ride on her back.



Orca Whales


Also called killer whales, orcas are the largest members of the dolphin family.

They are found in all oceans, killer whales are black on the back and sides, with white bellies and a white oval patch above and behind the eye.

Voracious predators, orcas feed on fish, squid, sharks, turtles, whales, seals, octopi, and birds.

Despite their size and ferocity, however, killer whales are not usually a threat to humans.

The madmen were no longer



a threat to people.

Remind

- 1. As you work together as a family, let your chores remind you of your lesson.

- 5. Say your memory verse!


Remarkable Parent Food







And He is just as willing to heal the sick now as when He was personally on earth. Christ's servants are His representatives, the channels for His working. He desires through them to exercise His healing power. **{DA 823.4}**



Continuing:

In the Saviour's manner of healing there were lessons for His disciples. On one occasion He anointed the eyes of a blind man with clay, and bade him, "Go, wash in the pool of Siloam.... He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing." John 9:7. The cure could be wrought only by the power of the Great Healer, yet Christ made use of the simple agencies of nature. While He did not give countenance to drug medication, He sanctioned the use of simple and natural **remedies. {DA 824.1}**








Thus He taught that disease is the result of violating God's laws, both natural and spiritual.




Continuing: We should teach them to believe in the Great Healer. We should lay hold on His promise, and pray for the manifestation of His power. The very essence of the gospel is restoration, and the Saviour would have us bid the sick, the hopeless, and the afflicted take hold upon His strength. **{DA 824.5}**



The power of love was in all Christ's healing, and only by partaking of that love, through faith, can we be instruments for His work. If we neglect to link ourselves in divine connection with Christ, the current of life-giving energy cannot flow in rich streams from us to the people. There were places where the Saviour Himself could not do many mighty works because of their unbelief. So now unbelief separates the church from her divine Helper. Her hold upon eternal realities is weak. By her lack of faith, God is disappointed, and robbed of His glory. **{DA 825.1}**
