Beluga Whale Profile

The frigid waters of the Antarc are home to many weird and wonderful animals, not least the smiling, hornless cousin of the Arctic Narwhal.

This may well be the happiest-looking member of the cetacean order: the beluga whale.

- ➤ This charming, brilliant white, bubble-headed whale has a perpetual grin. Possibly because despite humans' best efforts, their global **populations** seem to be doing relatively well.
- ➤ The majority of belugas **live** in the Arctic Ocean and areas around Alaska, Canada, Greenland, Scandinavia and Russia. Their population is thought to be around **200,000** in total worldwide.
- ➤ They are sometimes known as the **white whale** for obvious reasons, as well as the 'sea canary' due to its high pitched calls, and melonhead, due to its, erm, melonshaped head.
- ➤ Beluga whales are stocky in appearance, with a large percentage of it's body **blubber** (fat). They can grow up to 6m (20 ft) in **length** and **weigh** as much as 1,600 kg (3,500 lbs.).
- They are highly **social** creatures, live in pods and hunt together. They are opportunistic feeders and like to **diet** on cod, halibut, salmon, shrimp, squid, octopus and more.




Blue Whale Profile

The Blue Whale is a marine mammal, that's believed to be the largest animal that has ever lived, far bigger than even the largest dinosaur. They habitat the Antarctic Ocean, the North Atlantic, North & South Pacific and Indian Oceans.

They are members of the order Artiodactyla and family Balaenopteridae (or 'Rorquals'), the largest group of Baleen whales, which includes the humpback whale and fin whale.



- ➤ The Blue Whale (Balaenoptera musculus) prefer the deep ocean, rather than coastal waters or bays, and can be found living in any of the oceans located around the globe.
- They tend to spend the warmer months feeding in the polar regions, and will participate in extensively long migrations to the Equator as winter approaches.
- ➤ Blue Whales live typically between 80 and 90 years, with some reaching up to 110 years of age.
- They have a carnivore diet, but despite their size, these massive sea creatures prefer to eat some of the tiniest marine life. Blue Whales feast on plankton called krill, which is a small animal that resembles shrimp. Due to the relative sizes of both the blue whale and krill, they can consume as many as 40 million krill, or 8,000 pounds (3,600 kg) of it daily.

Killer Whale Profile

Orcas (Orcinus orca), often called Killer Whales, are actually the worlds biggest dolphins and are members of the Delphinidae family which also includes species such as Bottlenose Dolphins and Pilot Whales.

They inhabit most of the world's oceans, ranging from the equator to the polar regions. It's thought they got the misnomer "Killer Whale" from sailors who saw them hunting whales.





While they are still currently categorized as one species, scientists are now beginning to recognize that there are multiple types of Orca, which are likely sub-species or even different species all together.

Orcas are aquatic mammals (cetaceans), so they are warm-blooded and breath air. They are apex predators, meaning they are at the top of the food chain, and they often hunt marine mammals (seals, sealions etc.), fish and penguins.

They have complex social structures, some form pods composed mainly of matrilineal (descended from the mother) lines which will contain several generations of family members. Others form smaller transient groups which usually involves a mother and 2 offspring.

And then there are roving males, who never become part of a pod.

The ideal pH levels for each shade are as follows:

Blue = below 5.5 Purple= between 5.5 and 6.5


White = between 6 and 6.2 Pink = over 7

If your soil has varying **pH levels**, you could end up with a blend of colors!

- > Hydrangeas don't have petals.
 - Those beautiful petals aren't petals at all. They are sepals, which are leaves that protect the flower bud. Only after they age do they turn from green to the pigmented colors you see.
- > Their name has a Greek origin.
 - "Hydor" means water and "angos" means jar or vessel, emphasizing the need to water this particular flower often.
- > There are over 75 species of hydrangeas.

That being said, there are only six major ones that are grown in American gardens: bigleaf, smooth, panicle, oakleaf, climbing, and mountain. Each one requires a different type of soil, sunlight, and blooming time.

"The popular plant that most of us call "geranium" today was introduced to Europe by Dutch traders who brought them from South Africa in the early 18th century.

Because these new plants resembled the hardy wild geraniums already growing in Europe, botanists mistakenly grouped them together into the same genus.

In 1753, Swedish botanist Carl Linnaeus classified them under the genus Geranium. When it was later discovered that these new "geraniums" differed from European geraniums in the shape of their petals, the number of stamens, and other factors, they were reclassified under Pelargonium, meaning "stork's bill"—a reference to the long, sharply pointed shape of their seedpod."

The common geranium comes in a wide range of floral colors (red, orange, pink, white) in single or double flowers set high above lush, green leaves, sometimes bi-colored with bronze or purple markings. Once mature, most geraniums are 12 to 18 inches tall and 18 to 24 inches wide, depending upon the cultivar.

Begonias are popular flowering plants known for their vibrant colors and diverse forms. They belong to the family

Begoniaceae and are native to tropical and subtropical regions.

Types of Begonias

- Fibrous-rooted Begonias: Commonly grown for their colorful flowers and foliage.
- ➤ Tuberous Begonias: Known for their large, showy blooms and are often grown as annuals.
- ➤ Rhizomatous Begonias: Feature thick, fleshy stems and attractive leaves, often used for ornamental purposes.

 Growing Conditions
- Light: Prefer bright, indirect sunlight; too much direct sun can scorch leaves.
- > Soil: Thrive in well-draining, rich potting mix; avoid waterlogged conditions.
- ➤ Watering: Keep soil consistently moist but not soggy; reduce watering in winter.
- Toxicity: Begonias are mildly toxic if ingested, particularly the tuberous varieties.
- Keep away from pets and small children.

Nature Hummingbirds

We have learned that the hummingbird is the smallest bird, builds the smallest nest, and lays the smallest eggs. The ruby-throated hummingbird's nest is built high in the branches of the trees. She builds her nest of shreds of bark, soft grass, and bits of plant or cattail fluff. She sometimes covers the outside with lichen or bits of bark. This helps camouflage her nest. God kept Elijah camouflaged so Ahab and Jezebel could not find him. The female lays two tiny eggs about the size of navy beans. The young hatch in about two weeks. The babies have no feathers when hatched, and cannot see. In about three weeks they have their feathers and are strong enough to leave the nest.

The Bow of Promise

The rainbow is the gospel published in the sky. At a time in history when books and paper were not available like we have now, the rainbow was God's way to cheer men's hearts and keep them from being afraid. "And I will remember my covenant, which is between me and you and every living creature of all flesh; and the waters shall no more become a flood to destroy all flesh.

"And the bow shall be in the cloud; and I will look upon it, that I may remember the everlasting covenant between God and every living creature of all flesh that is upon the earth." (Genesis 9:12-16)

God said, "I do set my bow in the cloud." The rainbow is, in a special sense, God's bow, for a rainbow encircles His throne.
When John, on the Isle of Patmos, saw the throne of God in heaven, he saw that "there was a rainbow round about the throne, in sight like unto an emerald." (Revelation 4:3)

The prophet Ezekiel also saw visions of God. He saw "the likeness of a throne, as the appearance of a sapphire stone: and upon the likeness of the throne was the likeness as the appearance of a man above upon it.



"And I saw as the colour of amber, as the appearance of fire round about within it, from the appearance of his loins even upward, and from the appearance of his loins even downward, I saw as it were the appearance of fire, and it had brightness round about.

"As the appearance of the bow that is in the cloud in the day of rain, so was the appearance of the brightness round about. This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the Lord..." 

Those who had crossed the lake with Jesus told of all that had happened on the preceding night, of their peril in the tempest, and how the wind and the sea had been stilled. But their words were without effect. In terror the people thronged about Jesus, beseeching Him to depart from them, and He complied, taking ship at once for the opposite shore. {DA 339.1}


To many of the afflicted ones who received healing, Christ said, "Sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee."
