
Continuing: Satan was bitterly angry that his angels had fled at the approach of the heavenly messengers.

Dolphins and Whales


Whales live in groups called herds, pods, or schools. Whales with teeth are more organized in groups than baleen whales. Some types of dolphins swim in herds of 100 to 1,000. Dolphins are very friendly and smart mammals. They can be trained by man to do many things, even to throw and catch frisbees, and carry people on their backs. They make up their own games and especially like puzzles.

Dolphins are not easily fooled. One time a man wanted to film a movie about a dolphin rescuing a man. He asked his friend to jump into a pool with a trained dolphin named Sissy.

The man jumped in and acted like he was drowning. Sissy quickly swam over to help him and pushed him to the side of the pool where he was safe. But the man who was filming had forgotten to take the cap off the camera lens, so he asked his friend to jump in again. His friend did and pretended once more to be in trouble. But this time Sissy just swam over to him and spanked him with her flipper! Do you think that spanking was her way of trying to teach him **obedience** to the commandment "*thou shalt not bear false witness?*" (Exodus 20:16).



Often dolphins are part of the show at public oceanariums. People enjoy watching them **obey** commands and do tricks. There were three dolphins at a national aquarium in Maryland that developed ulcers because their tank did not allow room enough for them to “get away from it all.” There was no place to escape from the constant stream of people who enjoyed watching them. These dolphins teach us that when we disobey the rules of healthy, non-stressful living, we will suffer the consequences. After all, even Jesus occasionally needed a break from the crowds and therefore “He determined to seek retirement in some solitary place across the lake.” (*The Desire of ages* 333)




God gave the dolphins a permanent “smile.” It can remind us about how happy we will be when we are as **obedient** to God’s laws as the lovable dolphins are.

One of the most famous love affairs between dolphins and people is the story of Opo, a female who appeared in a New Zealand harbor in 1905. There she followed boats around the harbor and later visited the beach near Opononi. She enjoyed swimming and playing with the bathers, especially children with whom she played ball and to whom she gave “horsie rides.”

Dolphins and larger whales get along well with one another. A whale and a dolphin lived in adjoining tanks at an aquarium. They liked to swim together. So, when no humans were nearby, the whale would move the barrier between the two tanks so the dolphin could leap over it and join him. The whale seemed to sense his behavior was “illegal” because he would only do it when no one was around. It can remind us how the demoniacs wanted to travel with Jesus.

Some baleen whales, like the blue whale, live in a family group. The family consists of a bull (male), cow (female), and one or two offspring (calves). Baleen whales will gather in larger groups for feeding.



Humpback whales migrate in groups with mothers and their young, then males and non-pregnant females next, and last pregnant females. Each obey the laws of nature as to where they are to be.

Remember, whales communicate with one another by sound. Scientists do not know what information whales communicate. God, their Creator, knows. Someday, in heaven, He will reveal these secrets to us.

Most types of whales migrate between the polar and tropical regions. The cold waters of the Arctic and Antarctic are full of plankton. The summer is spent in these areas feeding and storing a reserve of blubber. Here the whales can find plenty of plankton to eat, which are very tiny sea animals. It is interesting that the world's largest animals feed on the world's smallest animals. So it is in our lives. The greatest are dependent on the services of the least. When winter comes, and polar waters freeze over, the whales move to warmer waters near the equator. There



they mate and females, already pregnant, give birth. The warm waters are a perfect place for babies without a thick layer of blubber. Here the whales usually live off their blubber as there is not much food. This reminds us of the demoniacs who had not had much spiritual food available so they used what they had seen and heard.

Some whales do not migrate, like the toothed whales, while the gray whales and humpbacks make very long migrations. Gray whales travel from arctic waters to the coast of Southern California (12,400 miles [19,964 kilometers]). They come to Baja California because the lagoons of shallow water make a nice safe baby pool for their nearly blubberless calves. The higher concentration of salt in the water make it easier for the newborns to swim.

Those who have visited one of the lagoons said the whales there enjoyed having their heads patted. They would go under the boat and seem to express joy by blowing bubbles all around it and sometimes lift it gently with their tails. The only thing the people had to be careful of was not to get their boat between a cow and her calf. The way the whales seem to enjoy the company of people visiting the lagoon shows how the demoniacs enjoyed Jesus' presence.

The life span of a whale can be from 15 years to 60 or more years. Whales have hardly any enemies except man, so most die of natural causes if they are not killed by man. As man is an enemy to the whales, so most men are enemies of God. God desires to draw all men to Himself as He drew the two demoniacs to be clean, obedient, and to follow and serve Him.

Remind

1. As you work together as a family, let your chores remind you of your lesson.
2. On a cold day when you have to shovel snow, or carry wood through a cold rain storm, remember where many whales feed. Remember how Jesus received a cool reception from the Gadarenes.
3. When you are hungry and it is not meal time yet, be reminded of how the whales live off their own fat when there is not food around.
4. Remember the permanent “smile” of the dolphins and be cheerful.
5. When you feel like going for a walk with someone in your family, remember how whales and dolphins like to swim along together and how the demoniacs wanted to be with Jesus.
