





Luke, in his account of the Saviour's burial, speaks of the women who were with Him at His crucifixion, and says: {SJ 157.1}

"They returned, and prepared spices and ointments;

and rested the Sabbath day according to the commandment." Luke 23:56. {SJ 157.2}

The Saviour was buried on Friday, the sixth day of the week.


The women prepared spices and ointments with which to embalm their Lord, and laid them aside, until the Sabbath was past. Not even the work of embalming the body of Jesus would they do upon the Sabbath day. **{SJ 157.3}**"And when the Sabbath was past a very early in the morning the first day.

Nature

Bats

In Palestine, the land of the Bible times, there are many mammals. One mammal that you might confuse with a bird is a bat. Why? Probably because it flies. We will study about this unusual mammal this week.


Remember a mammal has these characteristics:

- 1. Warm-blooded,
- 2. Has a backbone,
- 3. Two pairs of limbs,
- 4. More or less complete covering of hair
- 5. Feeds its babies with milk,
- 6. Most give their young protection and training, and
- 7. Mammals have a larger, more well-developed brain than other animals.





The Bible talks about Jesus' second coming in Isaiah 2. It mentions in verse 21 how wicked people, trying to flee from Him, will run into the caves, the home of bats, to hide from Him.



Bats are the only mammals that can fly. They have a furry body, and their wings are covered with smooth, flexible skin. Most bats live in caves, attics of buildings, under bridges, or other sheltered places. Some kinds live in trees. Most people do not know bats are around because they roost in dark places and come out at night. Bats hang upside down when they are resting. The bats can remind us of Jairus. It was unusual for a haughty person to seek the presence of the "Light of the World," just as it would be unusual for a bat who naturally likes darkness to come out into the daylight. But the sickness of his daughter drew Jairus to Jesus as the only help for her.

People have had many misunderstandings about bats. You might have heard someone say, "blind as a bat;" that is false because bats are not blind. Another misunderstanding is that bats get tangled in people's hair. Bats are very timid. As bats are misunderstood, so the disciples misunderstood why Jesus was helping the "haughty rabbi" ruler. Jesus came to this earth to show mercy unto all men.

There are so many different kinds of bats that live and act in so many different ways that we could say that bats are good examples of "exceptions to rules." It can remind us how there were different kinds of rabbis, and the haughty Jairus was an exception because he sought the help of Jesus. He teaches us not to give up on people who outwardly appear to have a bad character.



Most bats are harmless to people, but they can carry rabies, and for this reason should not be handled. Very few bats in the United States get rabies, and unlike most animals that get rabies, bats do not act aggressive when ill. They just fall to the ground and die. That is why you should never pick up any bat, as sick ones are the most likely to be found. Bats are man's helpers, as they eat large numbers of insects. When the insect-eating birds have gone to rest, the bats take over and patrol the skies on the wings of night.



Remind


- 1. As you work together as a family, let your chores remind you of your lesson.




Continuing: They did not ask for a blessing for themselves merely; they were weighted with the burden for the salvation of souls. The gospel was to be carried to the uttermost parts of the earth, and they claimed the endowment of power that Christ had promised. Then it was that the Holy Spirit was poured out, and thousands were converted in a day. **{DA 827.1}**



So it may be now. Instead of man's speculations, let the word of God be preached. Let Christians put away their dissensions, and give themselves to God for the saving of the lost. Let them in faith ask for the blessing, and it will come. The outpouring of the Spirit in apostolic days was the "former rain," and glorious was the result.
