#### Kitti's Hog-Nosed Bat or Bumblebee Bat-

Craseonycteris thonglongyai

#### **Description:**

The Kitti's Hog-Nosed Bat has a very unique look to it.

The fact that is so tiny also encourages the other name it is frequently called by - **Bumblebee Bat**. It is the smallest of all the species of bats that are in the world and it is also one of the smallest mammals in the world.

It weighs less than ¼ of an ounce and is approximately an inch in length. The ears are large when you consider the small size of the rest of the body. They do have a tail but many people don't think so. However, it is just so tiny that it is hard to see.

They have long wings and many people wonder how they are able to fly!

#### **Diet and Feeding Habits**

The fact that the Kitti's Hog – Nosed Bat lives very close to the water means they are usually able to find plenty of insects that they can eat. Flies are in high supply around this area and they make up most of the diet. They also consume lots of types of spiders. What is interesting is that the Kitti's Hog – Nosed Bat doesn't usually stop to eat. They will typically do it while they are still in flight.

# Touching His Garments

Because of the great lose of blood, it is thought the diseased woman had a severe case of anemia.

Anemia means the body does not have enough red cells in the blood or has lossed a lot of blood. It is shown by pale skin color, rapid beating of the heart, and a tendency to be tired most of the time.

Nettle contains a high amount of vitamins A, B, K, and C, as well as iron.



Avocadoes provide large amounts of iron, plus a little boost in folate levels.

#### 3. PARSLEY (PETROSELINUM CRISPUM)

Parsley juice has a high concentration of iron.

Vitamin C eases iron absorption, boosting the effects of iron supplements.




**Peacocks,** the male members of the peafowl species, are known for their vibrant plumage and elaborate courtship displays, primarily found in India and Southeast Asia.

**Peacocks**, also known as "peafowl, are large colorful birds that live in India and Asia. There are two species, blue peafowl and green peafowl. There is also a third, African species known as the Congo peafowl, but it is in a different genus. They are actually the males, and the females are known as "peahens." Read on to learn about the *peacock*.

**Description of the Peacock:** Male and female peafowl are drastically different in appearance. Peacocks are extravagant birds, with iridescent blue necks, and bright green tail feathers dotted with eyespots. Peahens are dull brown, with iridescent green necks and cream-colored heads.

**Diet of the Peacock:** Wild peacocks wander through the underbrush in search of food. They are omnivores, and feed on a variety of insects, seeds, grains, small mammals, flowers, fruits, berries, and small reptiles. They forage in groups, and usually remain on the ground while feeding. When they are not feeding, peafowl fly up into the trees to remain safe from predators.



Arguably, the porcupine — technically, the **North American porcupine** (*Erethizon dorsatum*) — is the Hudson Valley's oddest-looking creature. Everybody knows about their quills, but we discovered there's lots more to learn about these elusive mammals, including unusual calls and smells and the cutest baby name ever.

- ➤ Our nation's second-largest rodent (after beavers), porcupines can weigh up to **35 pounds.**
- Along with hair, their bodies sport up to 30,000 barbed quills, each 1-4 inches long. Made of keratin, the same substance found in our hair and fingernails, the quills detach easily when touched.
- ➤ On average, porcupines live 5-7 years, but some have been known to reach 20.
- ➤ **Porcupines'** elaborate mating rituals involve courtship dances and a host of <u>sounds</u> "whining, moaning, grunting, clicking of their teeth, in addition to wails, shrieks and siren-like screaming." Often, several males will compete for mating rights.
- Contrary to legend, porcupines can't shoot their quills, but they are able to raise them. They emit a pungent odor (likened to the smell of stinky cheese) to let predators primarily fishers, but also courageous owls and coyotes know they're serious about defending themselves. If cornered, they swing their tails like a mace.

#### "The Red Panda

(Ailurus fulgens), also known as the lesser panda, is a small mammal native to the eastern Himalayas and southwestern China. It has dense reddish-brown fur with a black belly and legs, white-lined ears, a mostly white muzzle and a ringed tail. Its head-to-body length is 51–63.5 cm with a 28–48.5 cm tail, and it weighs between 3.2 and 15 kg. It is well adapted to climbing due to its flexible joints and curved semi-retractile claws."

#### "Red Panda at Prospect Zoo

The red panda cubs at Prospect Park Zoo are a delightful addition to the zoo's Discovery Trail. Visitors can see these adorable cubs along the outdoor exhibit, where they are cared for by their mother, Willow. The cubs, named Qi and Liu, are part of a subspecies known as Styan's red panda, native to the eastern Himalayan range in China and northern Myanmar. They are not related to the giant pandas and belong to the superfamily that includes weasels, skunks, and raccoons. The cubs are currently on exhibit until 2 p.m. when they go inside for their nap, and their father will be on exhibit in the afternoon. The zoo's mission is to save wildlife and wild places worldwide through science, conservation action, education, and inspiring people to value nature."

The Silver pheasant is a species of pheasant found in forests, mainly in mountains of Southeast Asia, with introduced populations in Hawaii and various locations in the US mainland. The male is black and white in color, while the female is mainly brown. Both have a bare red face and red legs. The silver pheasant is common in aviculture, and overall also remains common in the wild, however, some of its subspecies are rare and threatened.

**Silver pheasants** are gregarious ground-dwelling birds that are usually seen in small flocks. Silver pheasants are active during the day and prefer to forage in the morning and in the evening. They spend most of their life on the ground and will fly only to escape danger. These birds communicate with the help of loud whistles, high-pitched chirping and during the courtship display, males produce cackles and grunts. The relationship between a male and female bird is called a pair bond. After the female responds to the courtship of the male they form a pair bond.

In the spring the male pheasant chooses and defends a territory. To attract a hen he makes <u>elaborate</u> displays

with cackles, crows, screams, and whistles. The hen only clucks and peeps. Absalom was very beautiful on the outside like the pheasant. He attracted many people to himself. Inside he was rebellious and <u>disobedient</u>. Instead of being a help to his father he attempted to take his kingdom. (He was not successful in the end.)

Like the male birds attracting a mate, Absalom had "courted the popular favor." He made an elaborate display of himself going about like he was the king. He also used his voice, like a male bird does in courtship, to woo the people to his side by "listening to their grievances, expressing sympathy with their sufferings and regret at the inefficiency of the government." He carried this courtship with the people so far that he made a practice of kissing those who came to him at the gate of the city.

Kookaburras (KUK-uh-bur-uhs) are woodland kingfishers that live in Australia and New Guinea. Their call sounds like a loud laugh. They are 17 inches (43 centimeters) long. Their heads are large with long, pointed bills. They are brown, black, and white, some with a little blue on their feathers.

Kookaburras eat caterpillars, frogs, fish, lizards, insects, small mammals, snakes, and worms. Their nests are built in tree holes, or even in holes in the side of the bank of a stream. There they lay two or three white eggs. The male bird is a good defender of the home against any predators. This can remind us of how Saul was not a good defender of Israel because he was not obedient to God. God cannot protect those who are willfully disobedient. However, God had already appointed a new king who would bring honor to Him.

#### **Description of the Kookaburra**

The kookaburra is a rather stout bird, with a medium length tail, and a broad beak. Its thick beak, also known as a "bill," is darker on top, and lighter on the bottom. They vary in color on top from dark brown to tan, and have a cream or white colored underbelly. The kookaburra's tail has a red hue, and is marked with black bars.

#### **Interesting Facts About the Kookaburra**

Kookaburras are an interesting species to say the least! Possibly the most well known Australian bird, the laughing kookaburra is a character that instills curiosity and wonder. Kookaburras hold the nickname of "The Bushman's Clock," due to their unique vocalizations. This name occurs because kookaburras are most vocal at sunrise and sunset, and thus could function as an alarm clock.

**Distribution of the Kookaburra** The original range of the kookaburra was eastern mainland Australia, but the laughing kookaburra has since been introduced to Western Australia, New Zealand, and Tasmania.
