



have been blessed to my eternal salvation. {ML 21.6}




Chapter 30 – Coming Again, Part 2

Continuing: Upon the earth, He said, there shall be “distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring; men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth.” **Luke 21:25, 26.** {SJ 175.6}

“And they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. And He shall send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.” **Matthew 24:30, 31.** {SJ 175.7}

The Saviour adds: “Now learn a parable of the fig tree; when his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer is nigh: so likewise ye, when ye shall see all these things, know that it is near, even at the doors.” **Matthew 24:32, 33.** {SJ 176.1}

Christ has given signs of His coming. He says that we may know when He is near, even at the doors. {Next Slide}



Continuing: Christ has given signs of His coming. He says that we may know when He is near, even at the doors.

When the trees put forth their leaves in the spring, we know that summer is near.

Just so surely, when the signs appear in the sun and the moon and the stars,
we are to know that Christ's coming is near. {SJ 176.2}

These signs have appeared. On **May 19, 1780**, the sun was darkened.

That day is known in history as **“the dark day.”**

In the eastern part of North America, so great was the darkness that in many places
the people had to light candles at noonday.

And until after midnight the moon, though at its full, gave no light.

Many believed that the day of judgment had come.

No satisfactory reason for the unnatural darkness has ever been given, except the reason
found in the words of Christ.

Continuing: The darkening of the sun and the moon was a sign of His coming. {SJ 176.3}
November 13, 1833, there was the most wonderful display of falling stars ever beheld by men.
Again thousands believed that the day of judgment had come. {SJ 176.4}
Since that time earthquakes, tempests, tidal waves, pestilence, famine,
and destructions by fire and flood, have multiplied.
All these, and “distress of nations, with perplexity,
“ declare that the Lord's coming is near. {SJ 176.5}

Matthew 14:23 (KJV) And when he had sent the multitudes away, he went up into a mountain apart to pray: and when the evening was come, he was there alone.





Cats Are Mammals

A mammal has these characteristics:


1. Warm-blooded,
2. Has a backbone,
3. Two pairs of limbs,
4. More or less complete covering of hair,



5. Feeds its babies with milk,
6. Most give their young protection and training, and
7. Mammals have a larger, more well-developed brain than other animals.



Palestine was once the home of many cats—the cats of the Bible. There were lions, leopards, and cheetahs roaming in the land where Jesus lived. *Song of Solomon* mentions “the mountains of leopards” (4:8). I wonder if there were any on the mountain that Jesus climbed after he sent away the multitudes and the disciples. Most of these cats have disappeared from the Bible lands. The main difference between the big cats and all other cats is that big cats can roar but cannot purr. Other cats can purr but cannot roar.



Lions hum when happy, cough to warn others away, woof when frightened, and deserted cubs bleat mournfully. Two lions greeting one another puff at each other, while an angry lion hisses or snarls. Cubs seem to meow a lot! What kinds of sounds do thankful people make?


